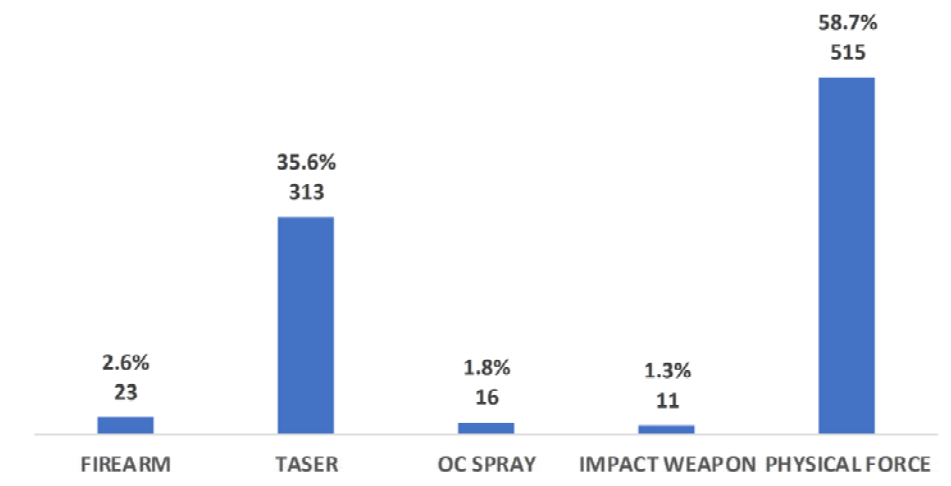

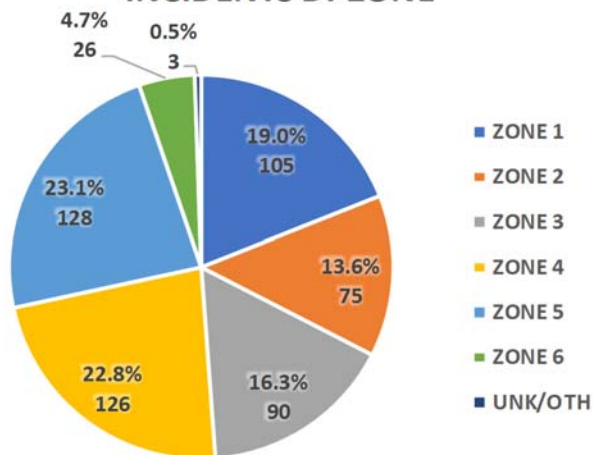
- **553** POLICE RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE INCIDENTS IN 2019
  - 542 RTR REPORTS FROM ARMOR
  - ELEVEN (11) OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTINGS NOT INCLUDED IN ARMOR
  - 537 RTR REPORTS INVOLVED PEOPLE AS SUSPECTS (11 INVOLVED ANIMALS; ONE [1] DID NOT HAVE SUSPECT LISTED)
- **878** POLICE USES OF FORCE
  - 23 USES OF FORCE (17 INCIDENTS) INVOLVED USE OF A FIREARM BY THE OFFICER
  - NINE (9) SUSPECTS WERE SHOT; SIX (6) SUSPECTS WERE FATALLY SHOT
  - FOUR (4) NEGLIGENT/ACCIDENTAL FIREARM DISCHARGES EXCLUDED FROM TOTAL

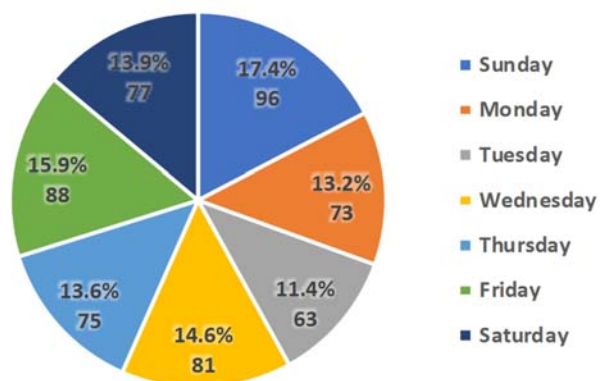

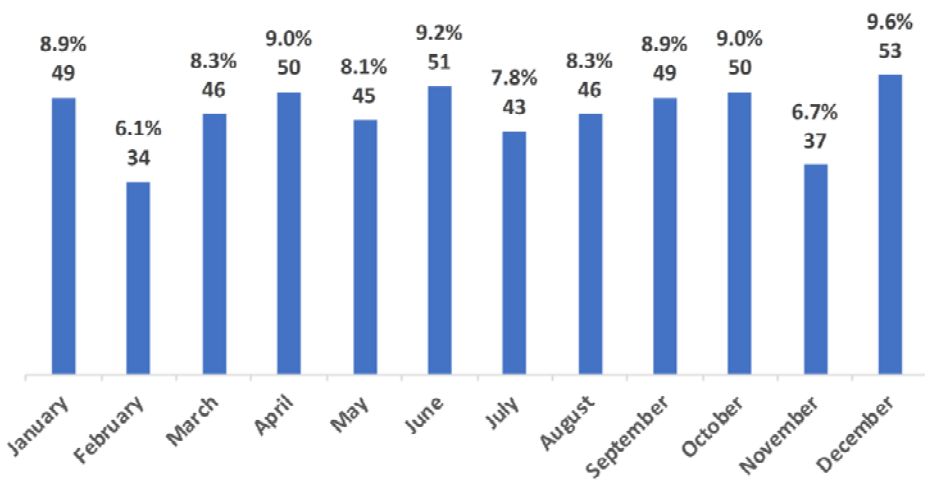
INCIDENTS BY ZONE



INCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK

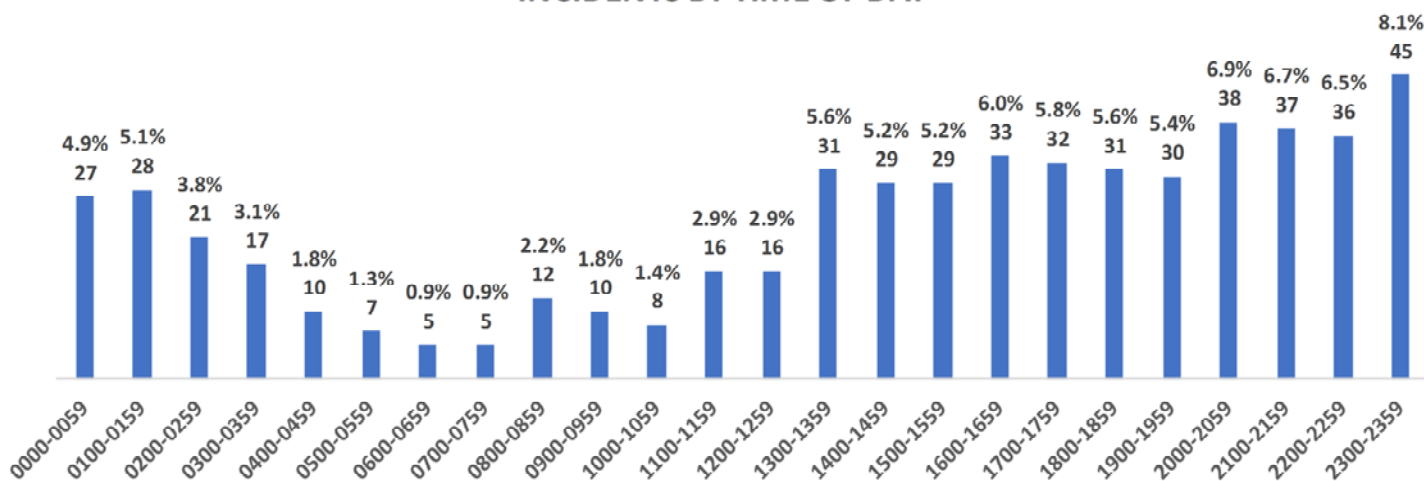

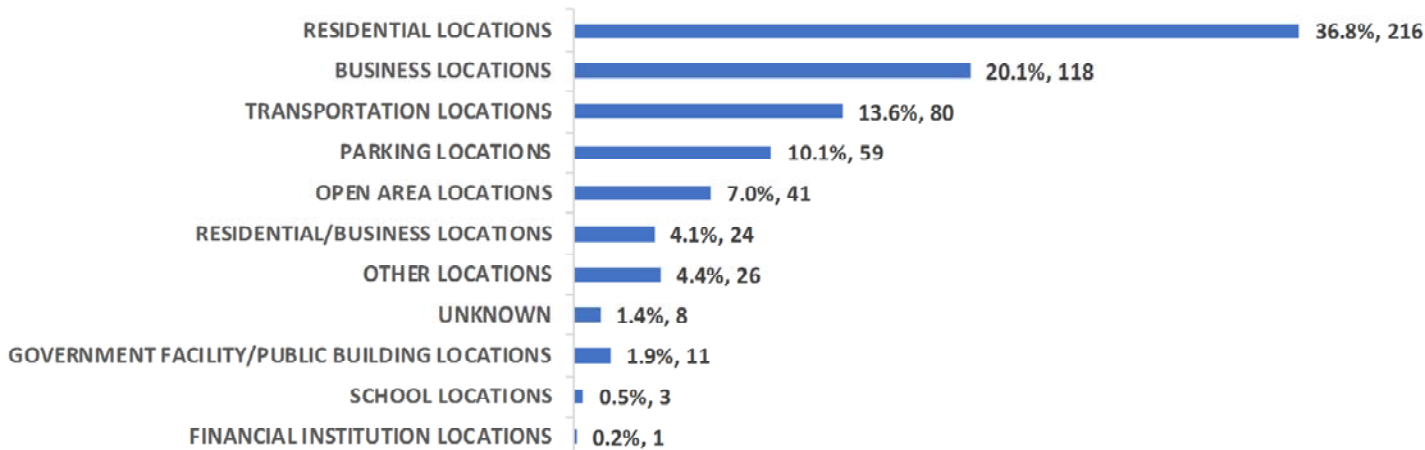


- ZONE 5 ACCOUNTED FOR THE MOST RTR INCIDENTS, WITH 128 (23.1% OF TOTAL)
- SUNDAY ACCOUNTED FOR THE MOST RTR INCIDENTS AT 96 (17.4% OF TOTAL) AND FRIDAY WITH THE SECOND MOST AT 88 (15.9% OF TOTAL)
- DECEMBER WAS THE BUSIEST MONTH WITH 53 INCIDENTS (9.6% OF TOTAL), FOLLOWED CLOSELY BY JUNE WITH 51 INCIDENTS (9.2% OF TOTAL)
- LATE AFTERNOON/EVENING HOURS ACCOUNTED FOR THE MOST RTR INCIDENTS

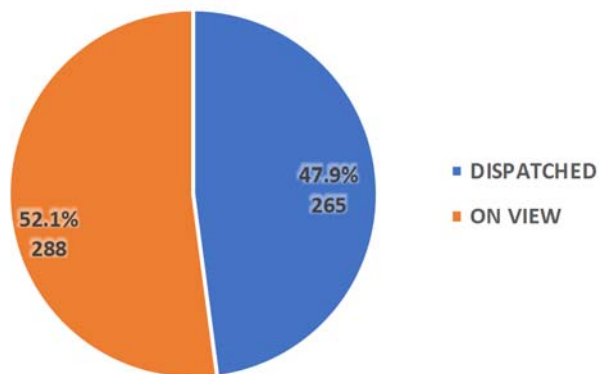
INCIDENTS BY TIME OF DAY



### INCIDENTS BY LOCATION TYPE



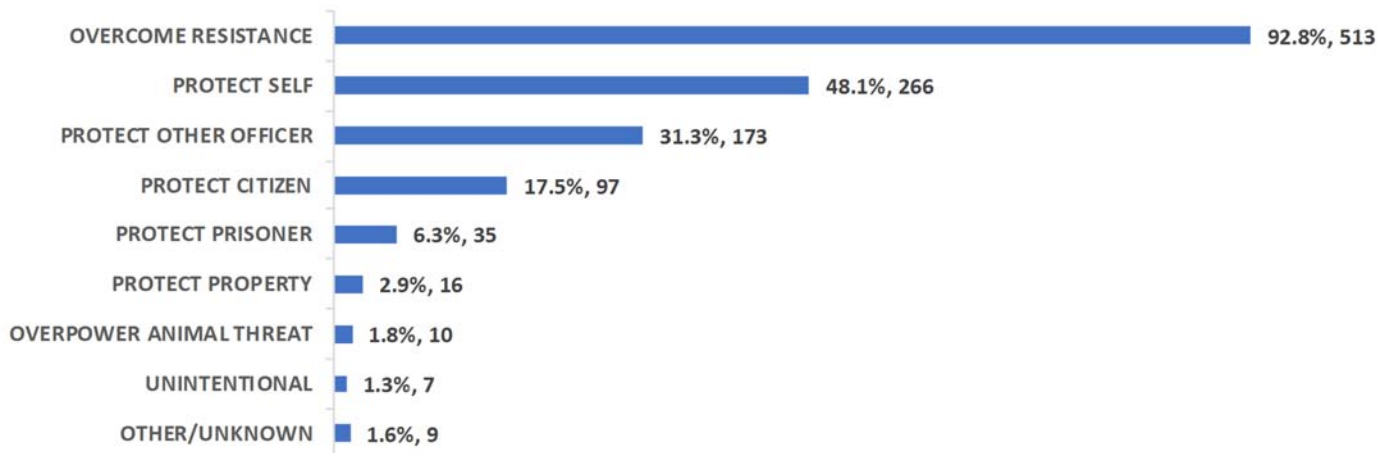

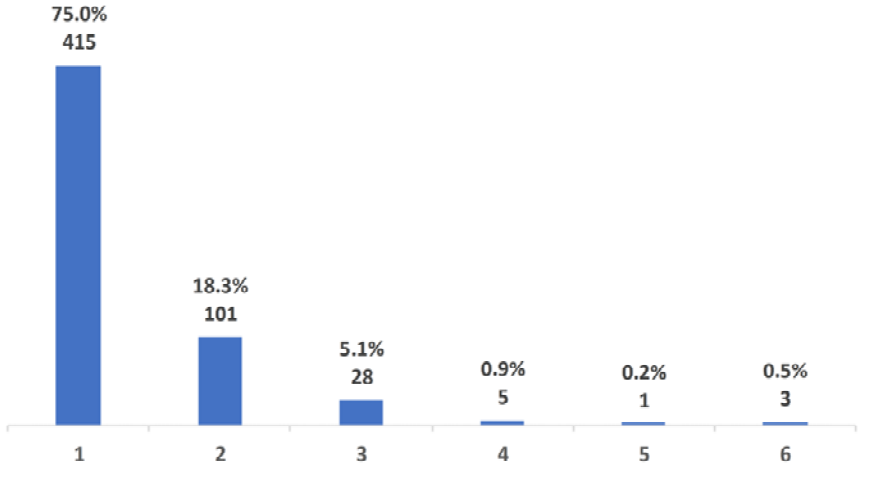
- RESIDENTIAL LOCATIONS ACCOUNTED FOR THE LARGEST PERCENTAGE OF RTR INCIDENTS, WITH 216 INCIDENTS (36.8% OF TOTAL)
- 265 INCIDENTS INVOLVED OFFICERS BEING DISPATCHED, WHILE 288 INCIDENTS INVOLVED OFFICERS WHO WERE ON VIEW AT THE INCIDENT
- NEARLY ALL INCIDENTS (513 OUT OF 553), INVOLVED THE OFFICERS USING FORCE IN ORDER TO OVERCOME RESISTANCE FROM THE SUSPECT(S)

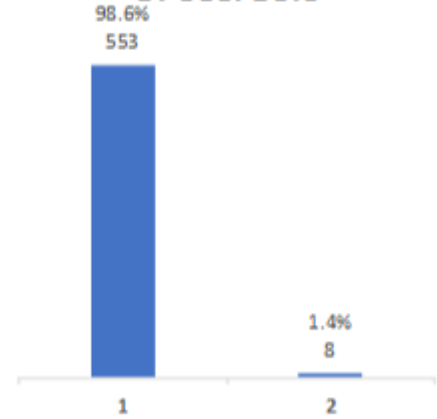

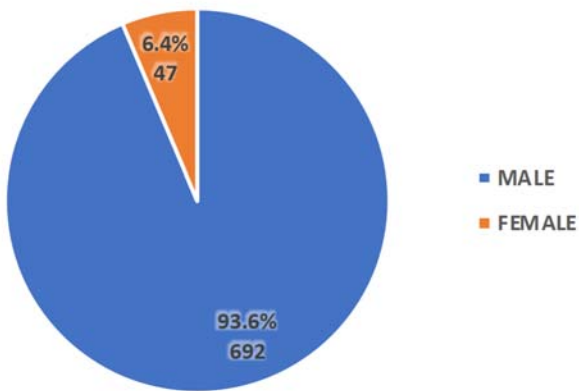
INCIDENTS BY NUMBER OF OFFICERS



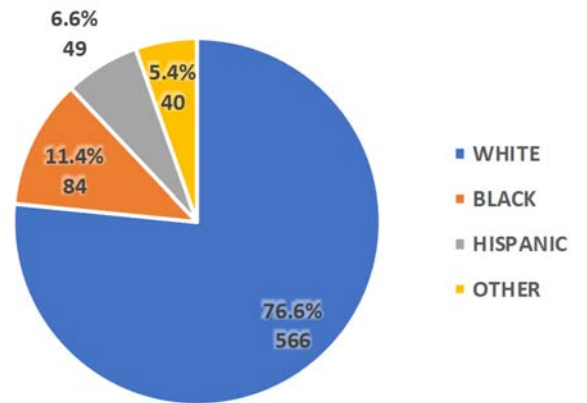
INCIDENTS BY NUMBER OF SUSPECTS



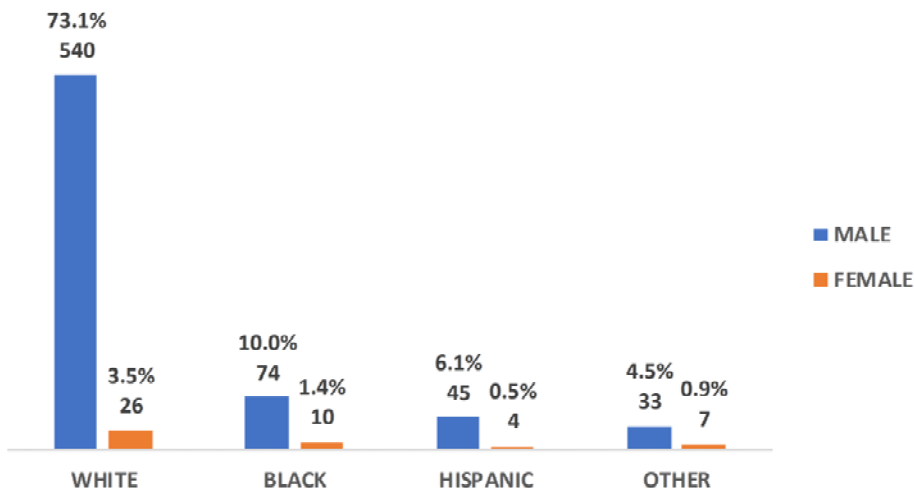
POLICE OFFICERS BY GENDER

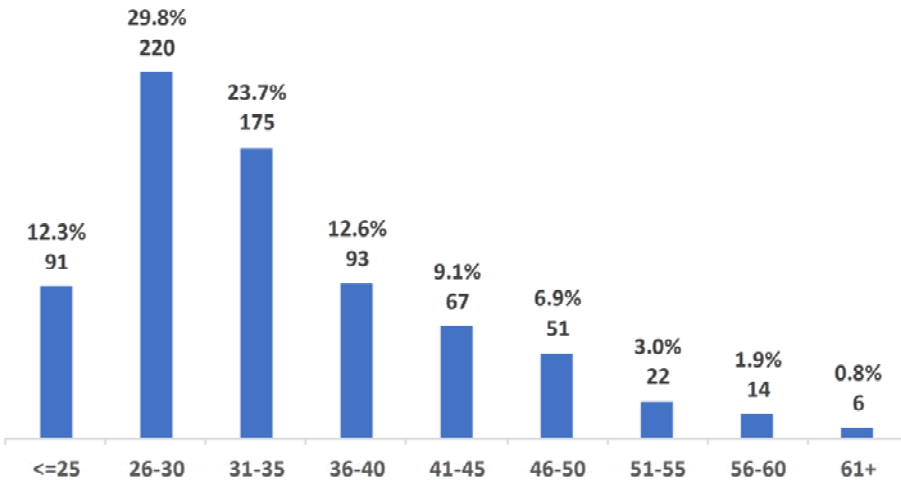

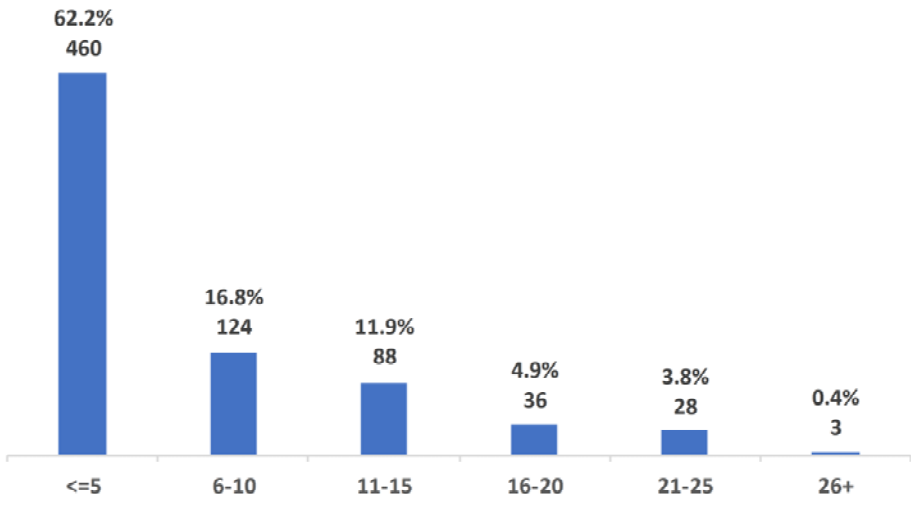

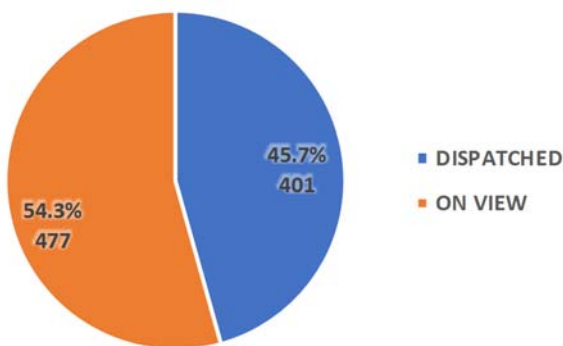


- 65.8% OF POLICE OFFICERS WERE AT OR UNDER THE AGE OF 35

- 45.7% OF USES OF FORCE INVOLVED A POLICE OFFICER THAT WAS DISPATCHED TO THE SCENE
- 90.1% OF POLICE OFFICERS WERE ON DUTY

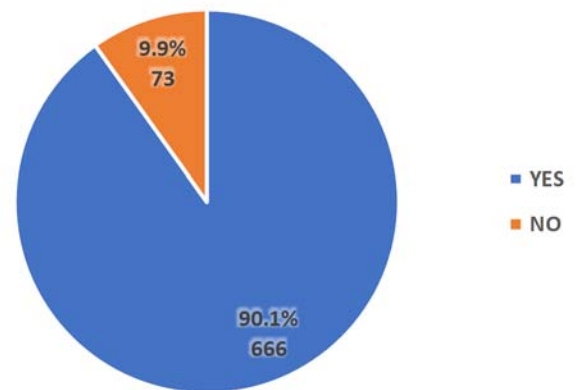
POLICE OFFICERS BY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE



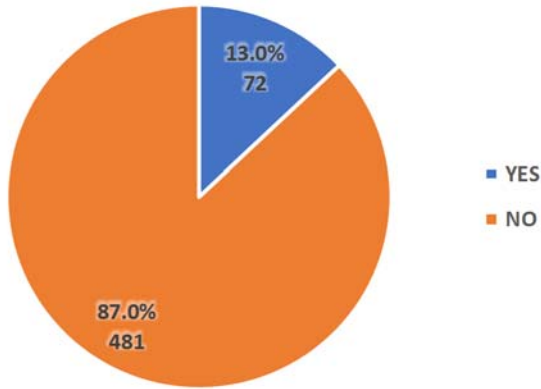
USE OF FORCE CALL TYPE

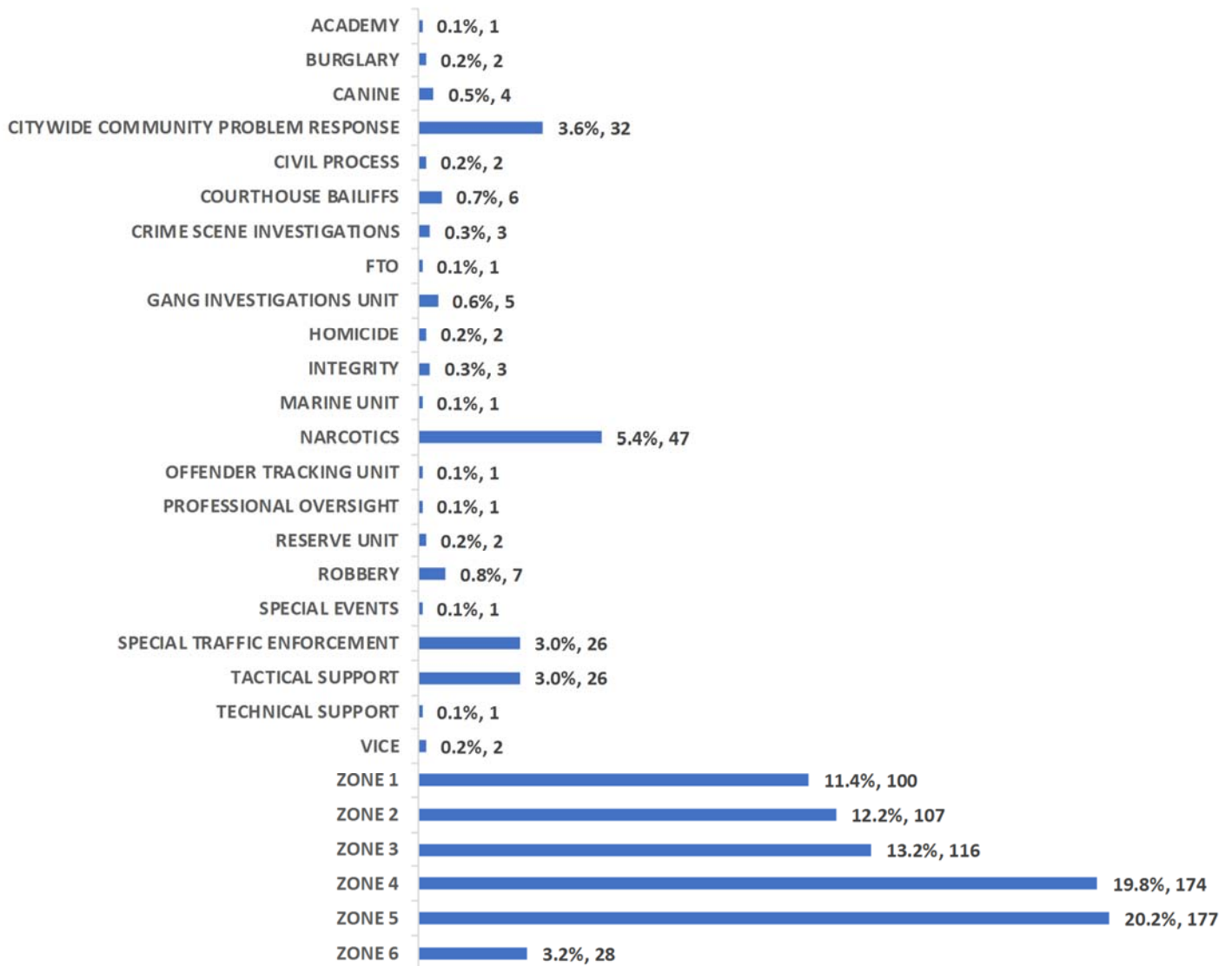

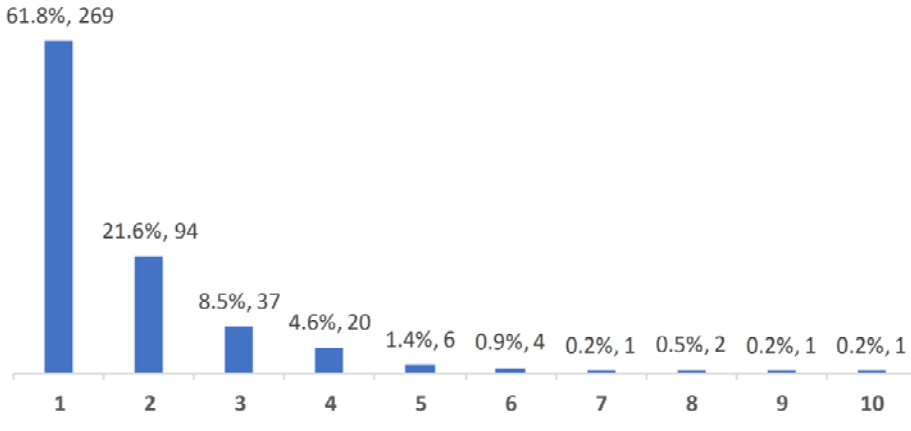

  - 77 OFFICERS TOTAL WERE INJURED
  - NO OFFICERS WERE SHOT
- ZONE OFFICERS ACCOUNTED FOR THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE (80%) OF ALL USE OF FORCE POLICE OFFICERS; THE NEXT HIGHEST NUMBER INVOLVED WERE NARCOTICS OFFICERS AT 5.4%

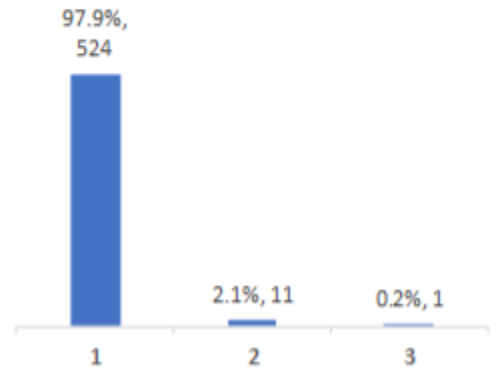




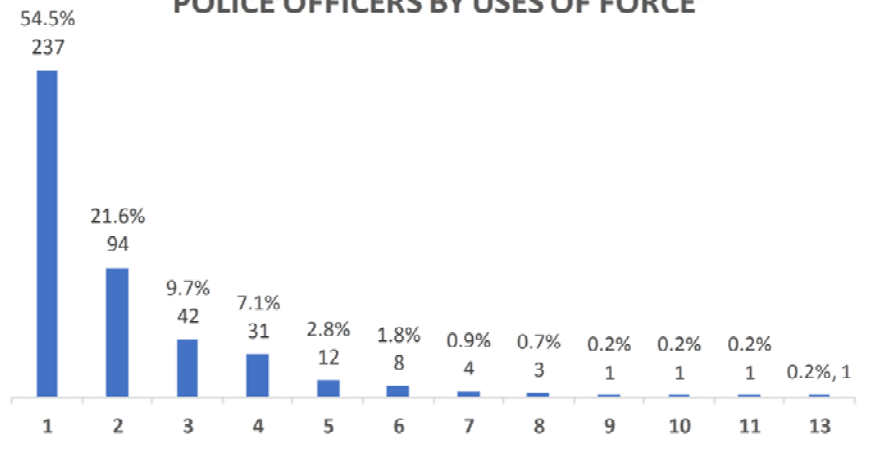

POLICE OFFICERS BY NUMBER OF INCIDENTS**



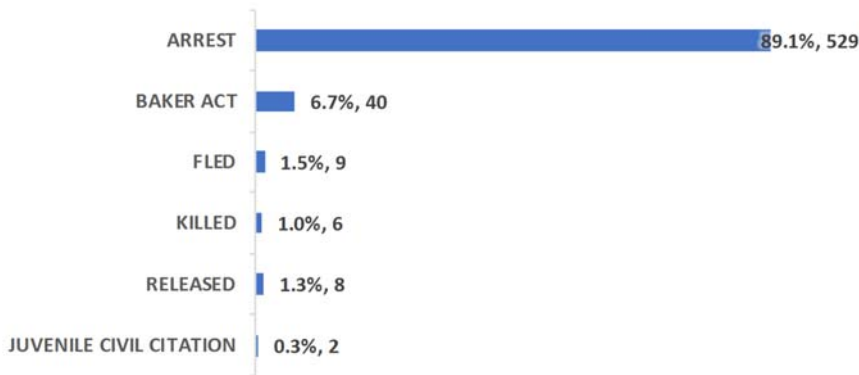

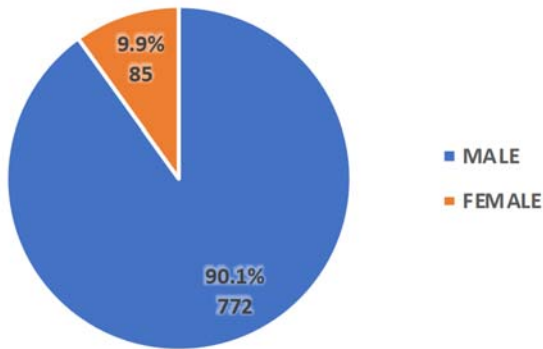

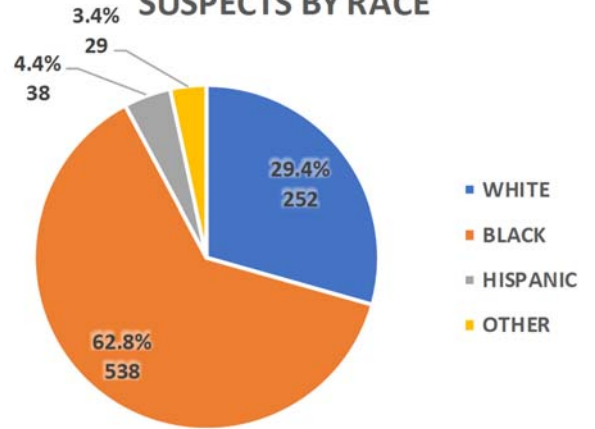

- 12 SUSPECTS (2.3%) WERE INVOLVED IN MORE THAN ONE (1) INCIDENT
  - OUT OF 538 INCIDENTS
- 54.5% OF OFFICERS UTILIZED ONLY ONE (1) USE OF FORCE
- 538 OUT OF 553 INCIDENTS INVOLVED A PERSON OR PERSONS AS SUSPECTS
  - 14 INVOLVED ANIMALS
  - ONE (1) DID NOT HAVE SUSPECT LISTED
- 536 DIFFERENT INDIVIDUALS WERE INVOLVED
  - 11 SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN TWO (2) INCIDENTS, 1 SUSPECT INVOLVED IN THREE (3) INCIDENTS
  - EIGHT (8) INCIDENTS INVOLVED TWO (2) SUSPECTS

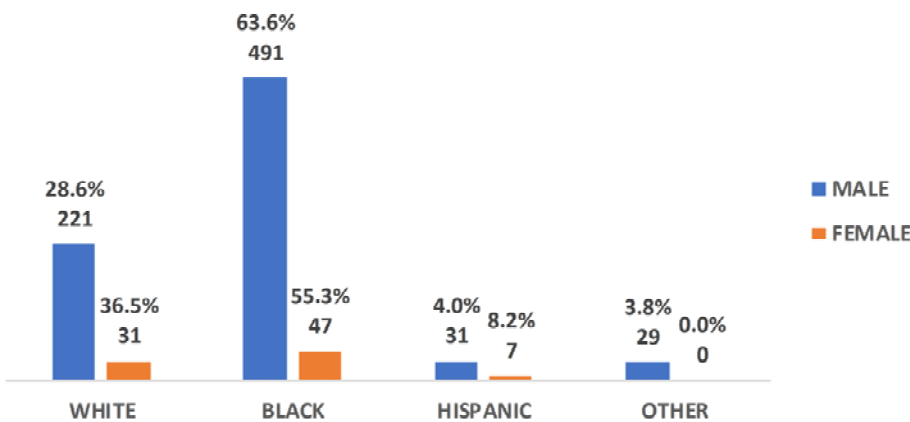
USE OF FORCE  
SUSPECTS BY GENDER



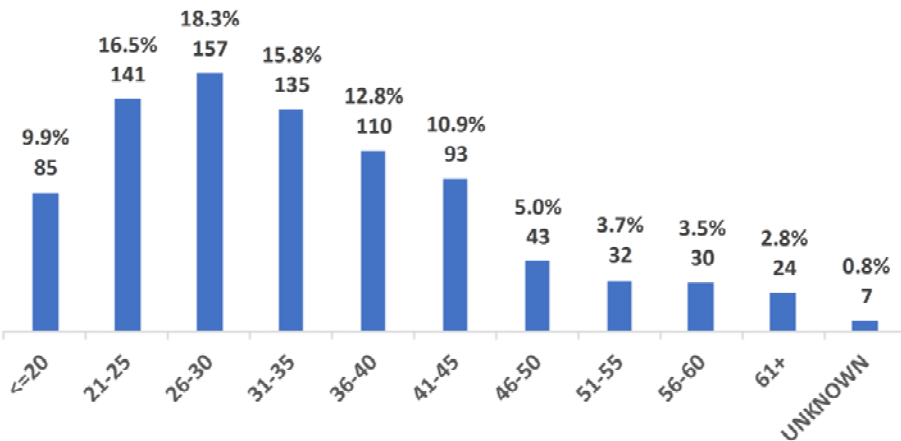
USE OF FORCE

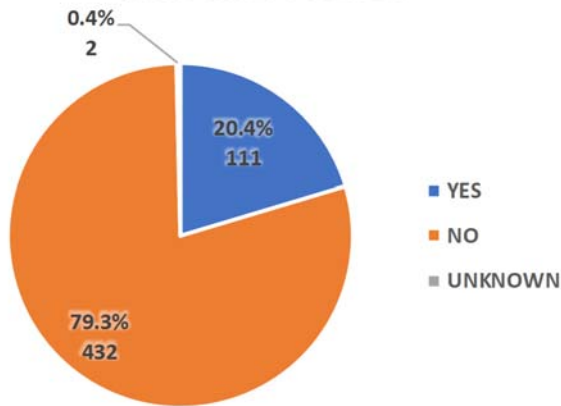

- 538 (62.8%) USES OF FORCE INVOLVED BLACK SUSPECTS
- 57.3% OF USES OF FORCE INVOLVED BLACK MALE SUSPECTS
- 63.6% OF THE MALE SUSPECTS AND 55.8% OF THE FEMALE SUSPECTS INVOLVED WERE BLACK
- 60.4% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED WERE 35 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER
- 38 (4.4%) OF ALL USES OF FORCE INVOLVING PEOPLE (857) AS SUSPECTS, ALSO INVOLVED JUVENILE SUSPECTS

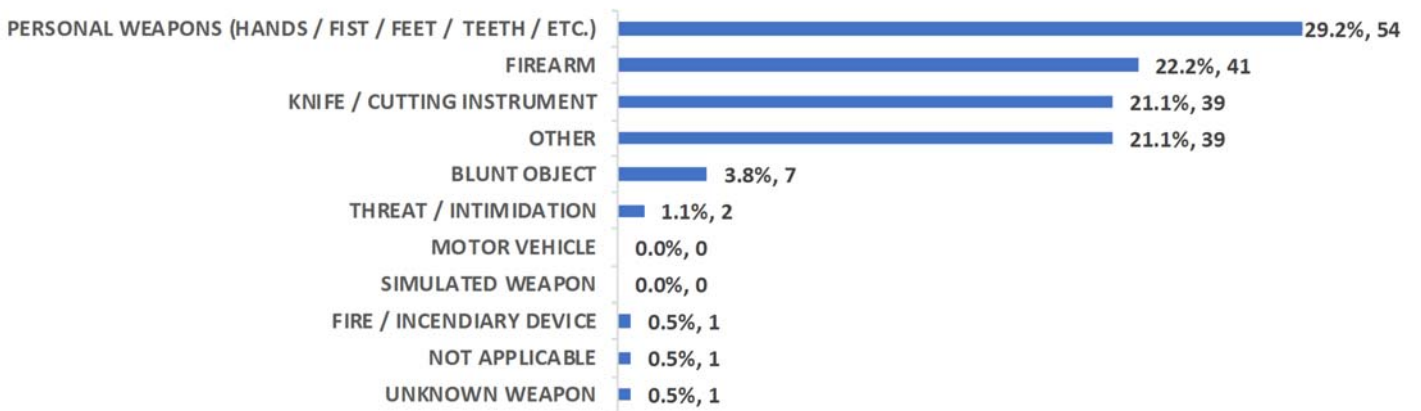

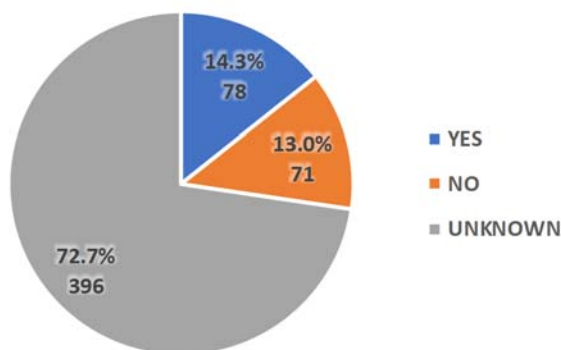
- 111 OUT OF 536 (20.4%) TOTAL SUSPECTS WERE REPORTED AS BEING ARMED
- 22.2% OF ALL WEAPONS WAS A FIREARM (INCLUDING HANDGUNS, RIFLES AND SHOTGUNS)
- 14.3% OF SUSPECTS WERE REPORTED AS USING DRUGS PRIOR TO RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE
- 18.3% OF SUSPECTS WERE REPORTED AS USING ALCOHOL PRIOR TO RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE

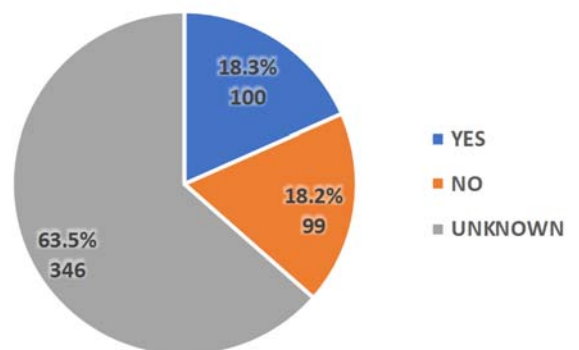

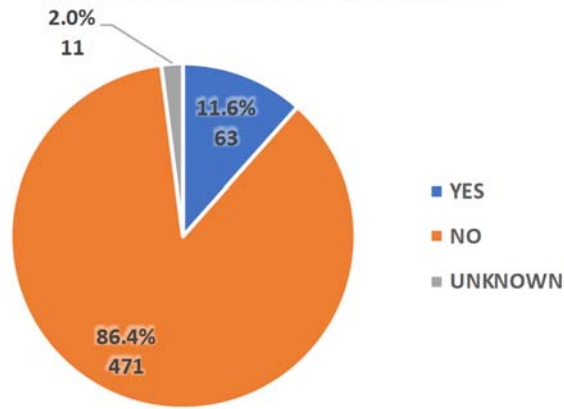
USE OF FORCE  
SUSPECTS DRUG USE



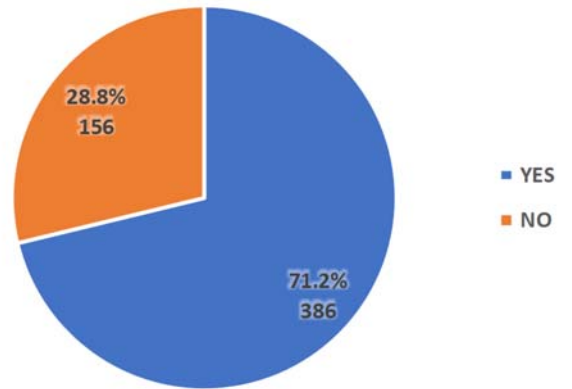

SUSPECTS ALCOHOL USE



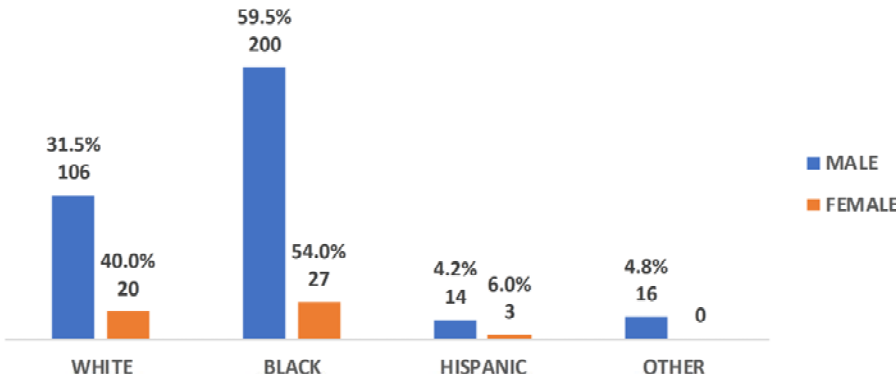

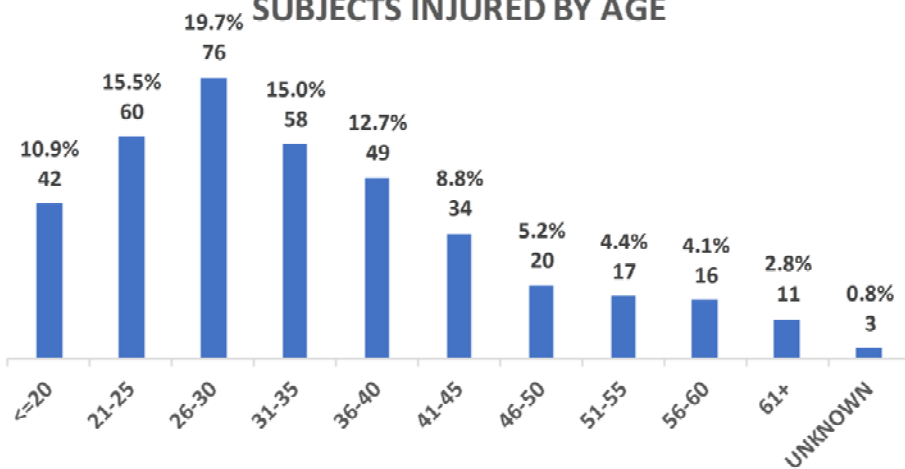

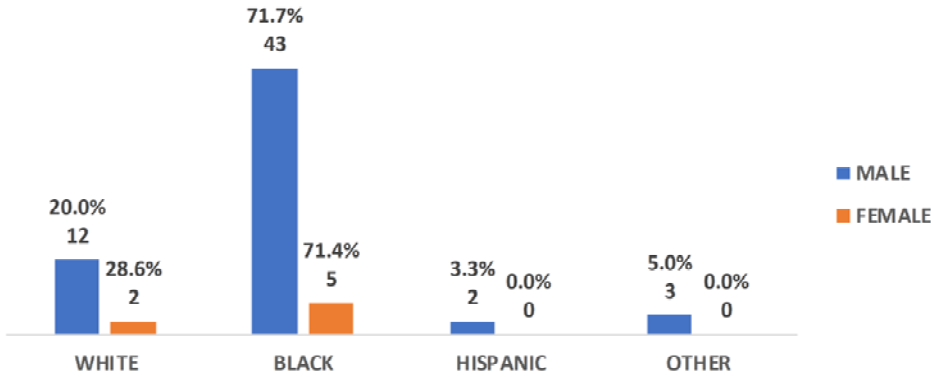


- 63 OUT OF 536 (11.6%) SUSPECTS EXHIBITED SIGNS OF EXCITED DELIRIUM
- 386 OUT OF 536 (71.2%) SUSPECTS WERE REPORTED AS BEING INJURED
  - SIX (6) WERE FATALLY SHOT
- BLACK MALES COMPRISED 51.8% OF SUSPECTS WHO WERE INJURED
- 61.1% OF SUSPECTS INJURED WERE 35 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER
- 4.9% OF SUSPECTS INJURED WERE JUVENILES

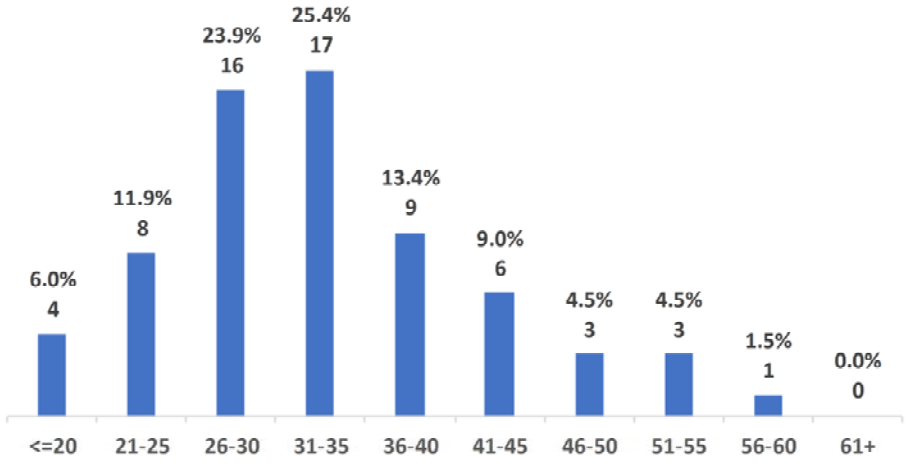

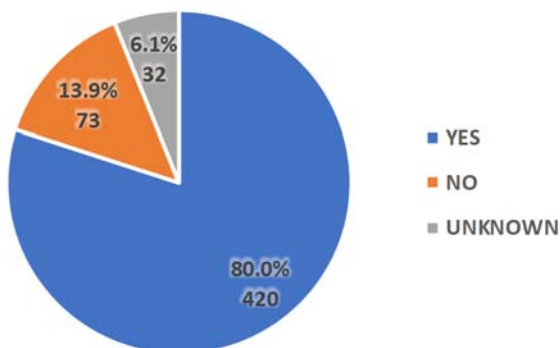


- BLACK MALES COMPRISED 64.2% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED WHEN AN OFFICER WAS INJURED IN THE COURSE OF THE RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE
- MOST (67.2%) SUSPECTS WERE 35 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER WHEN AN OFFICER WAS INJURED DURING THE RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE
- THE 386 INJURED SUSPECTS WERE REPORTED AS HAVING 525 INJURIES TOTAL
- 420 OUT OF THE 525 (80%) INJURIES WERE A RESULT OF THE RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE
- SIX (6) INJURIES (1.1%) WERE FATAL; ALL WERE GUNSHOTS

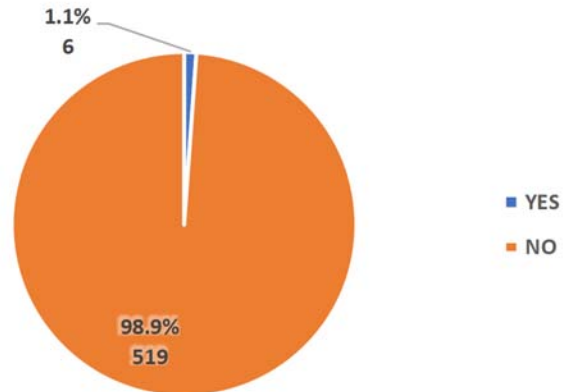

OFFICERS INJURED; SUSPECTS BY AGE



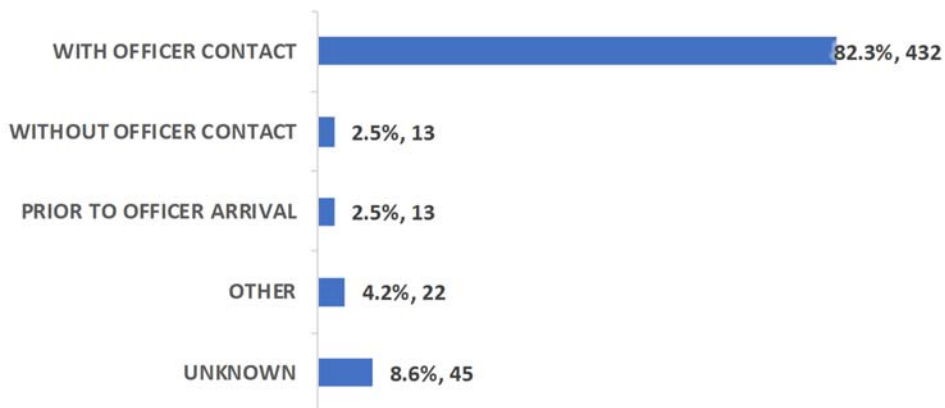
USE OF FORCE

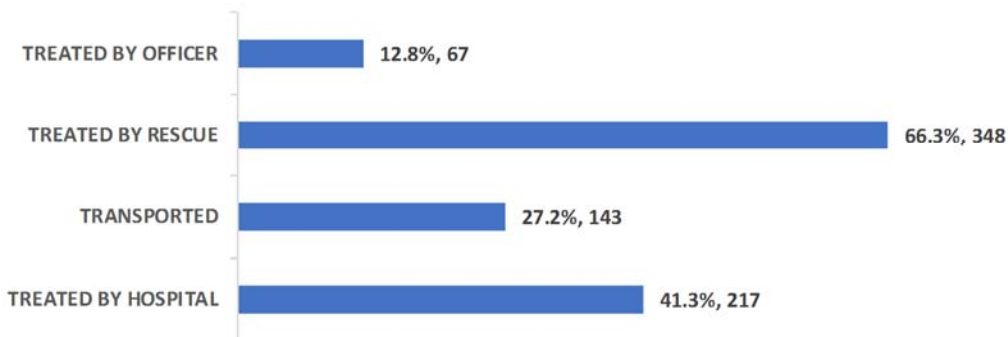

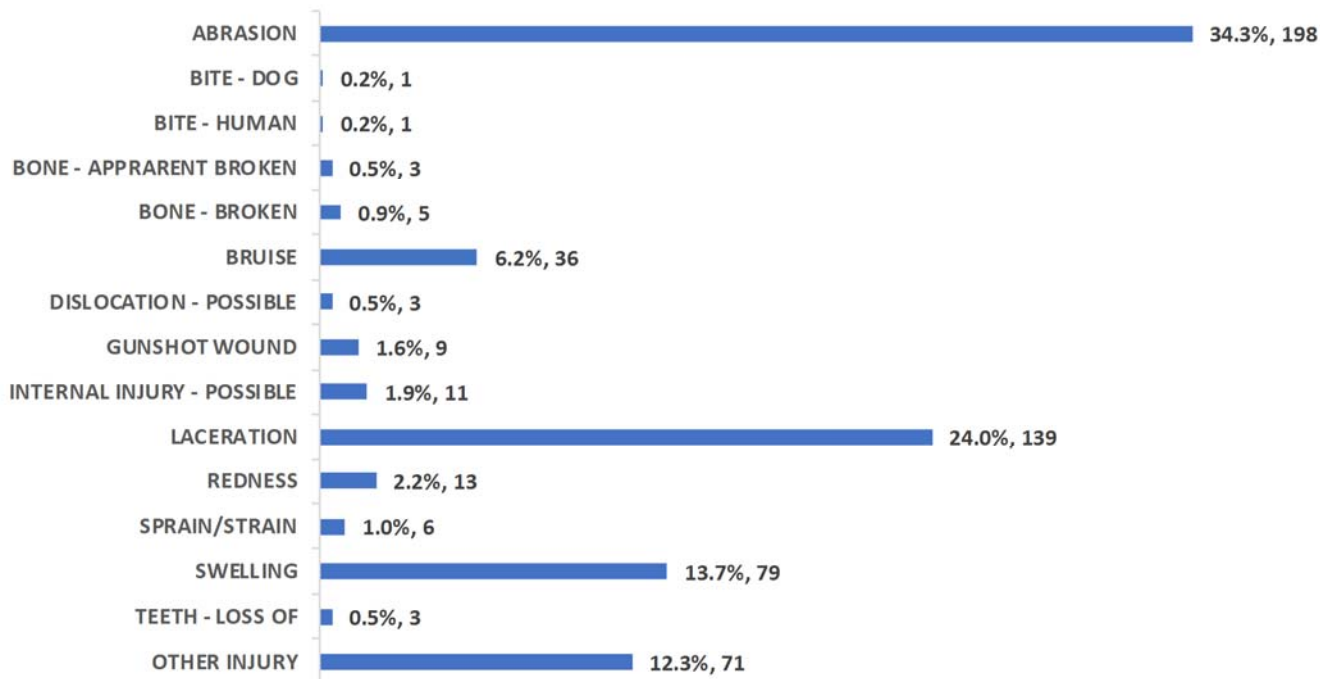
- MAJORITY OF SUSPECT INJURIES (82.3%) WERE A RESULT OF CONTACT WITH POLICE OFFICERS
- MAJORITY (66.3%) OF SUSPECT INJURIES WERE TREATED BY RESCUE
- ABRASIONS AND LACERATIONS COMPRISED MOST OF THE REPORTED SUSPECT INJURIES, AT 34.3% AND 24% RESPECTIVELY

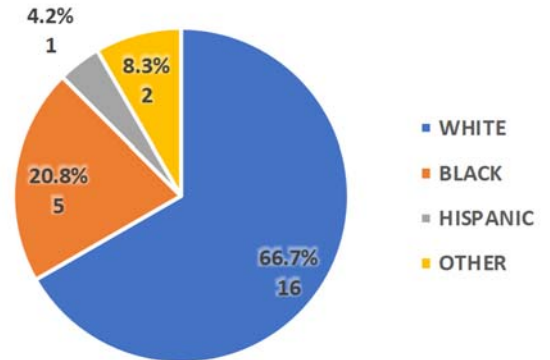

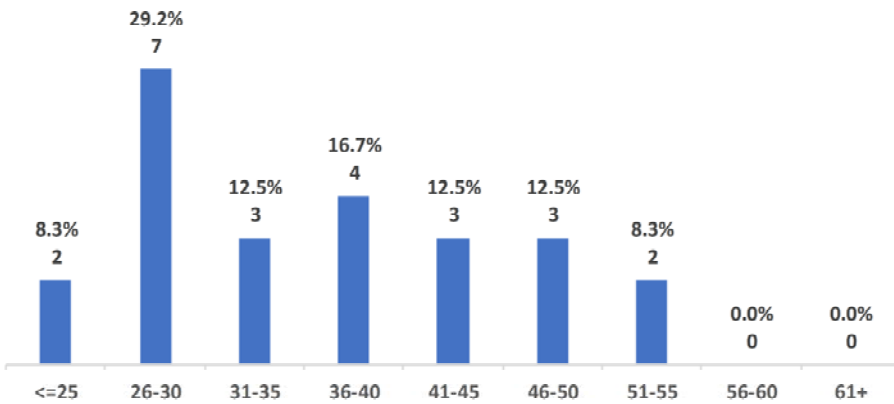
**POLICE FIREARM USAGE**

- 17 INCIDENTS (24 USES OF FORCE) INVOLVED USE OF A FIREARM
- ONE (1) OFFICER WAS INVOLVED IN TWO (2) INCIDENTS.
- ELEVEN (11) DIFFERENT SUSPECTS WERE INVOLVED IN ELEVEN (11) FIREARM RELATED USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS WHERE A PERSON AS A SUSPECT WAS INVOLVED
- ALMOST ALL OFFICERS INVOLVED IN FIREARM USAGE WERE MALE (95.83%)
- 66.7% OF THE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN FIREARM USAGE WERE WHITE (AS COMPARED TO 76.4% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)

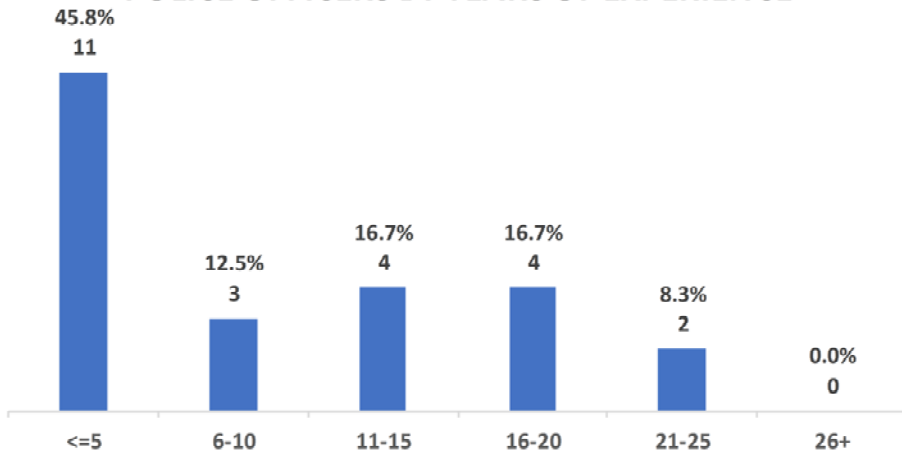

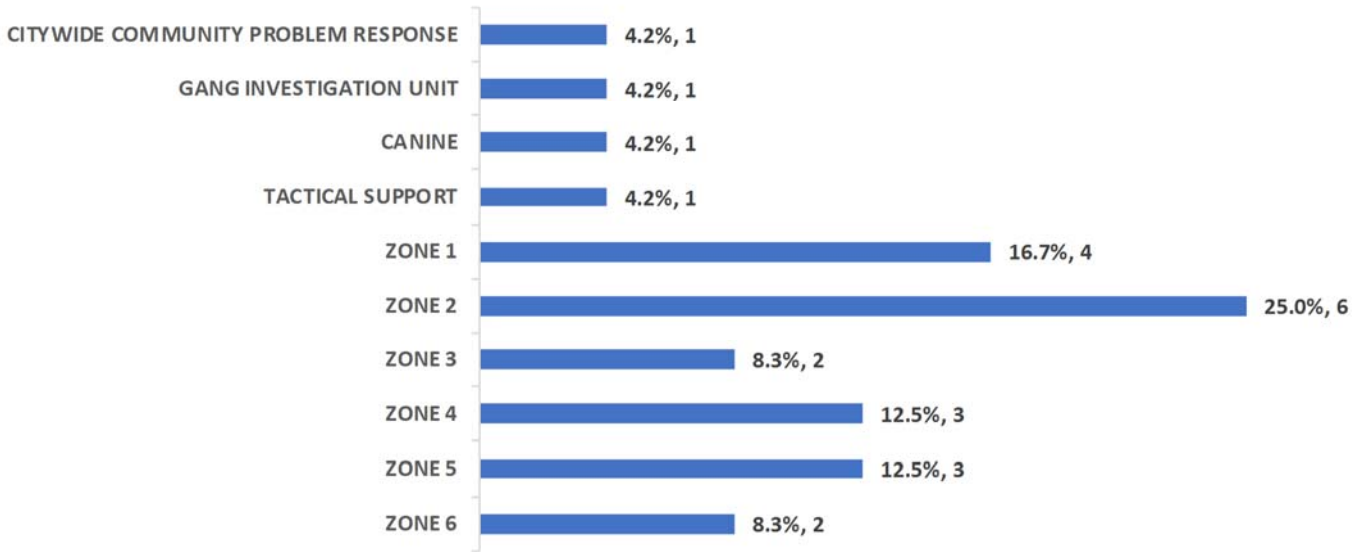


- 50% OF THE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN FIREARM USAGE WERE AT OR UNDER THE AGE OF 35 (AS COMPARED TO 67% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 58.3% OF THE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN FIREARM USAGE HAD TEN (10) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE OR FEWER (AS COMPARED TO 79.8% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- ALL OFFICERS (100%) INVOLVED IN FIREARM USAGE INCIDENTS WERE ON DUTY (AS COMPARED TO 91.2% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)

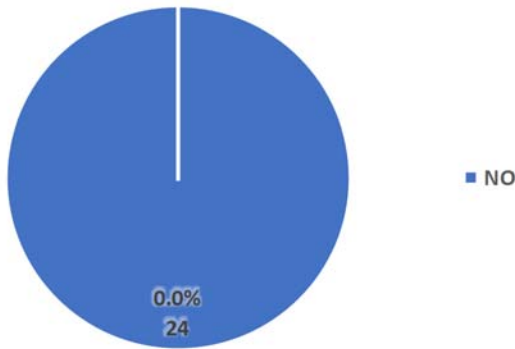
**FIREARM POLICE OFFICERS BY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE**

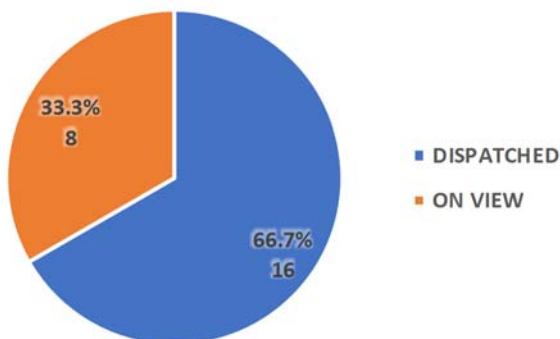

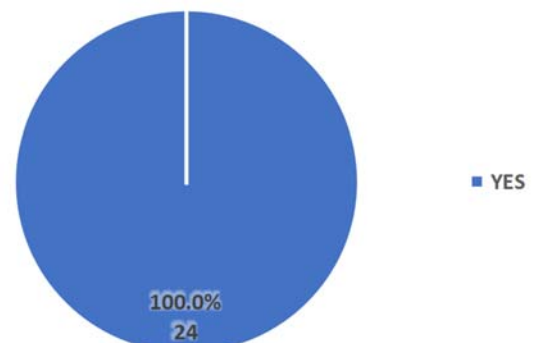

SUSPECTS BY GENDER



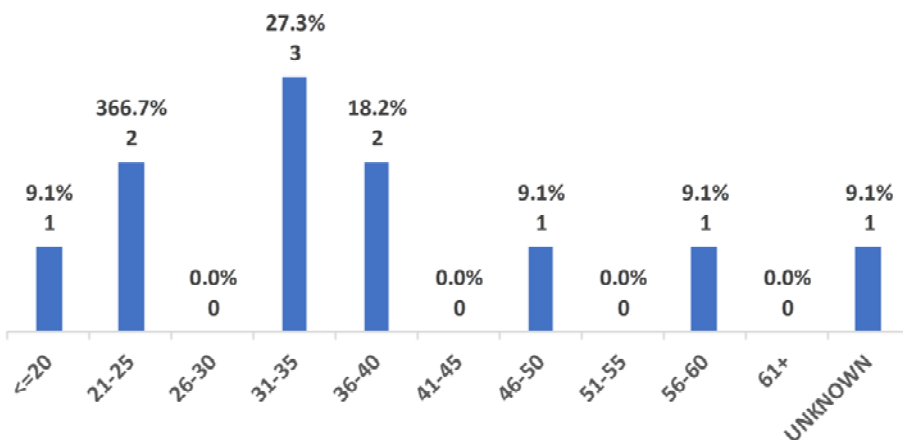

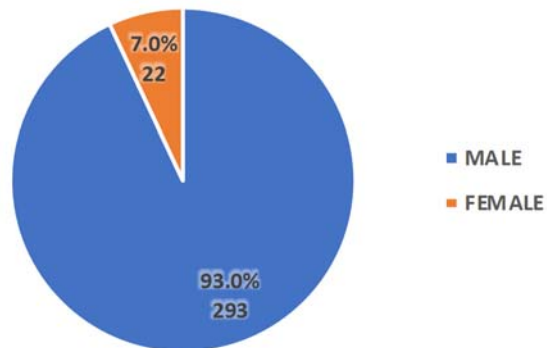

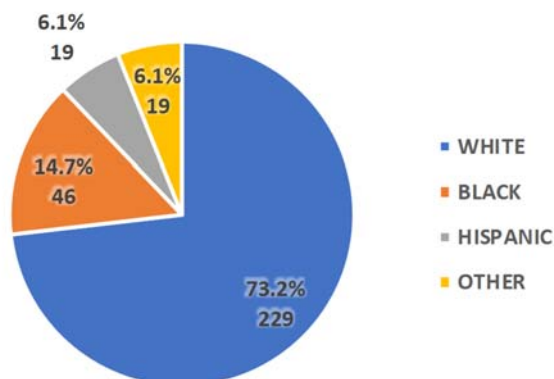
- ELEVEN (11) USES OF A FIREARM WERE ON PEOPLE AS SUSPECTS, REMAINING SIX (6) WERE ON ANIMALS
- ALL OF THE SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN FIREARM RELATED USES OF FORCE WERE MALE (AS COMPARED TO 90.1% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 63.6% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN FIREARM RELATED USES OF FORCE WERE BLACK (AS COMPARED TO 62.8% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- FOUR (4) WHITE MALES AND SEVEN (7) BLACK MALES WERE INVOLVED IN FIREARM DISCHARGED RELATED USES OF FORCE (AS COMPARED TO BLACK MALES COMPRISING 57.3% OF SUSPECTS IN USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS)
- 54.5% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN FIREARM RELATED USES OF FORCE WERE AT OR UNDER THE AGE OF 35 (AS COMPARED TO 60.4% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- IN THE ELEVEN (11) FIREARM RELATED INCIDENTS INVOLVING PEOPLE, THE SUSPECTS WERE ARMED WITH HANDGUNS IN FIVE (5) INCIDENTS, A KNIFE IN FIVE (5) INCIDENTS AND UNARMED IN ONE (1) INCIDENT

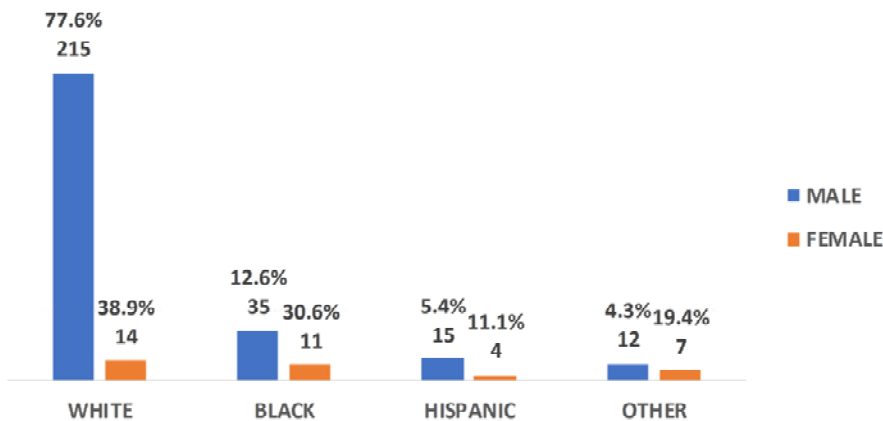

POLICE OFFICERS BY GENDER**



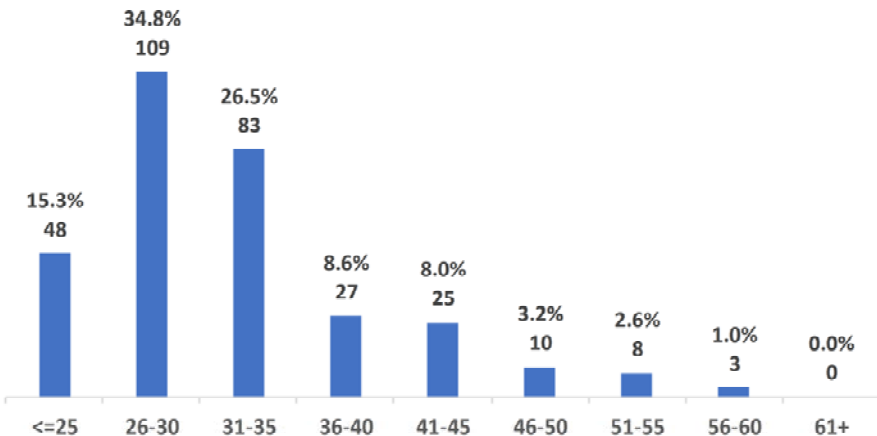

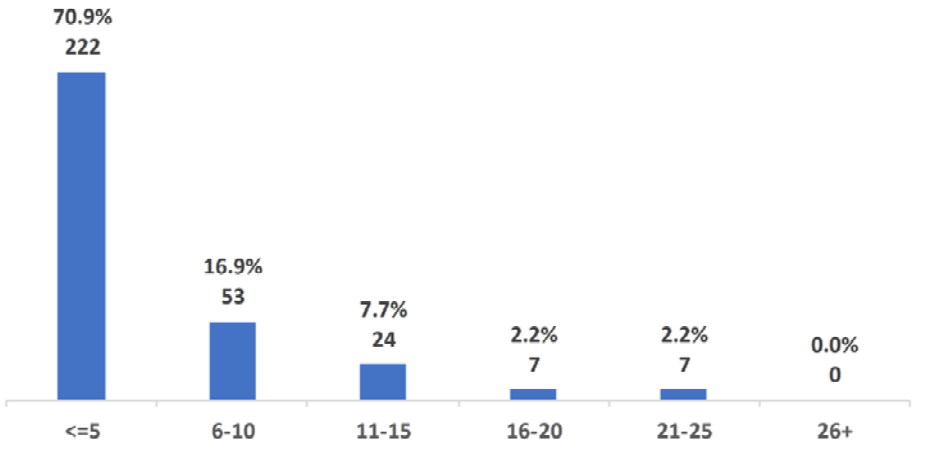

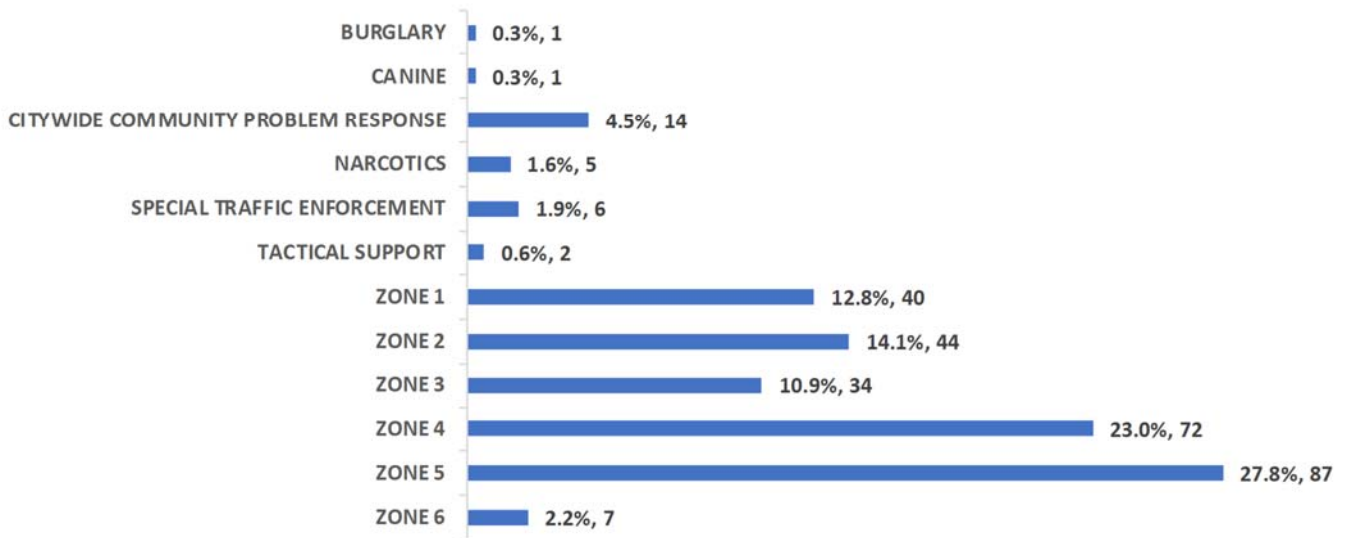

- 251 DIFFERENT SUSPECTS WERE INVOLVED WITH USE OF A TASER
- 93% OF USES OF FORCE WITH USE OF A TASER INVOLVED MALE OFFICERS (AS COMPARED TO 93.6% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 73.2% OF USES OF FORCE WITH USE OF A TASER INVOLVED WHITE OFFICERS (AS COMPARED TO 76.6% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- IN 215 OUT OF 313 (68.7%) USES OF FORCE INVOLVING A TASER, THE OFFICERS WERE WHITE MALES (AS COMPARED TO 72.8% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- IN INCIDENTS INVOLVING A TASER, MORE FEMALE OFFICERS TENDED TO BE BLACK, WITH 30.6%, COMPARED TO 12.6% OF THE MALE OFFICERS

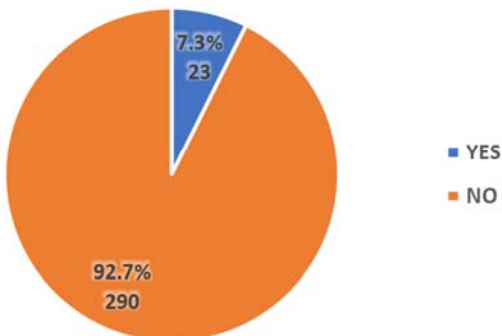

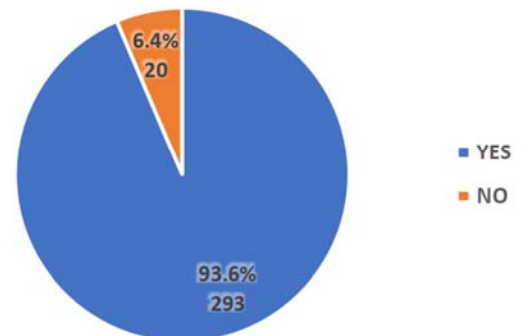

POLICE OFFICERS BY DIVISION**



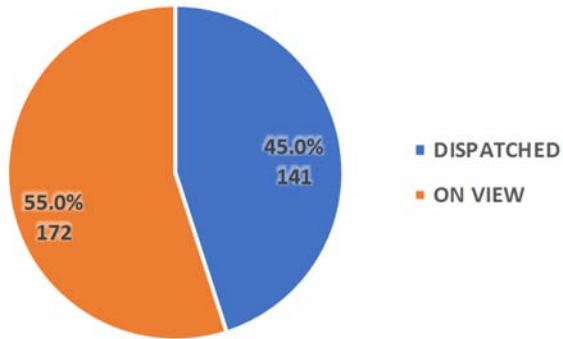

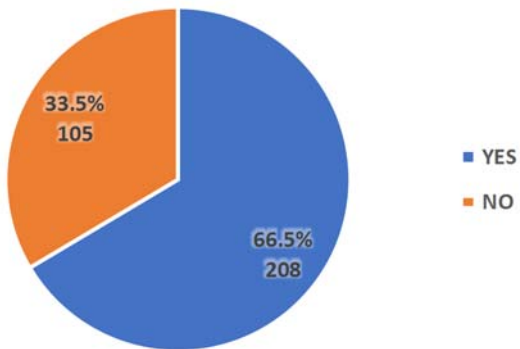

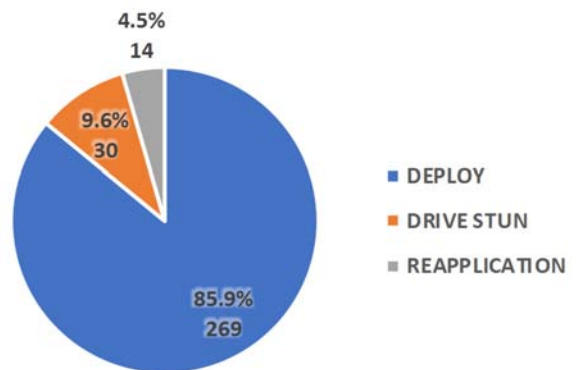


- MAJORITY OF USES OF FORCE INVOLVING A TASER INVOLVED AN OFFICER WHO ON VIEWED THE ACTIVITY, WITH 55% (AS COMPARED TO 54.3% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- IN 66.5% OF USES OF FORCE INVOLVING A TASER, THE TASER MADE CONTACT WITH THE SUSPECT
- MAJORITY OF TASER USES WERE DEPLOYMENTS, WITH 85.9% OF ALL USES
- 94.9% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN TASER RELATED USES OF FORCE WERE MALE (AS COMPARED TO 89.7% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 69.9% OF SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN TASER RELATED USES OF FORCE WERE BLACK (AS COMPARED TO 62.8% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)

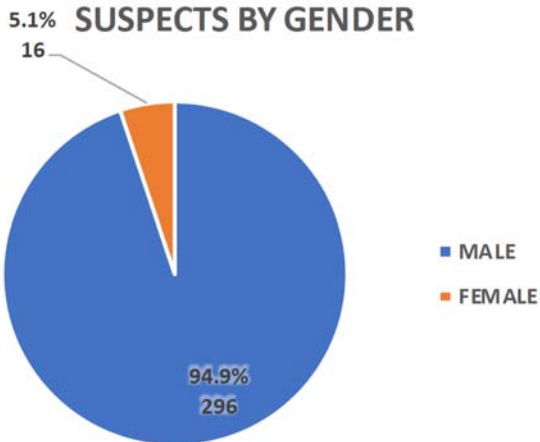

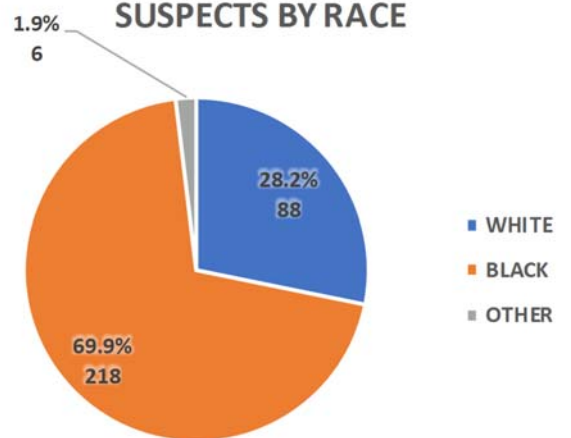
TASER DEPLOYMENT TYPE



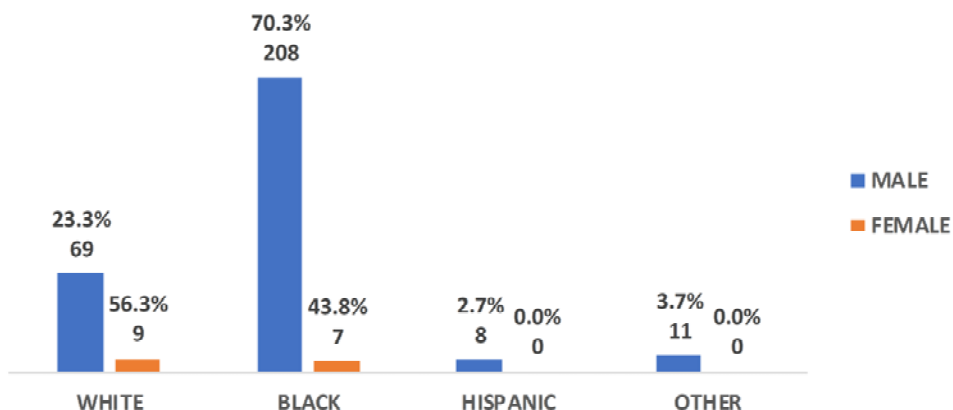
TASER SUSPECTS BY GENDER

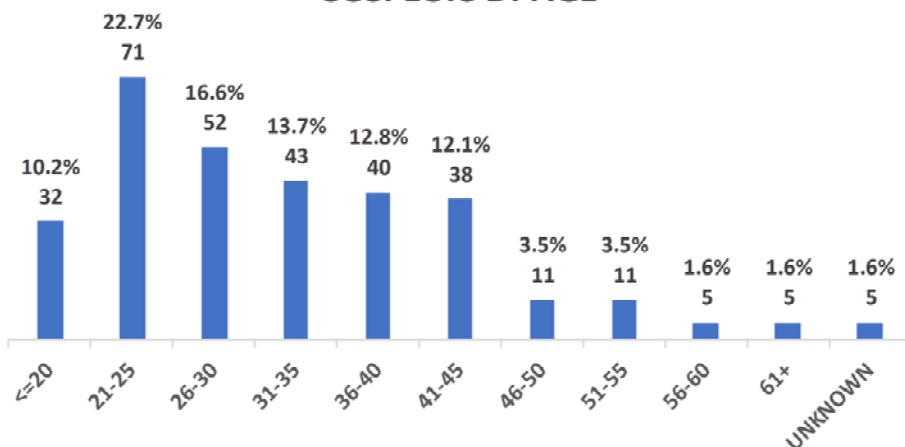

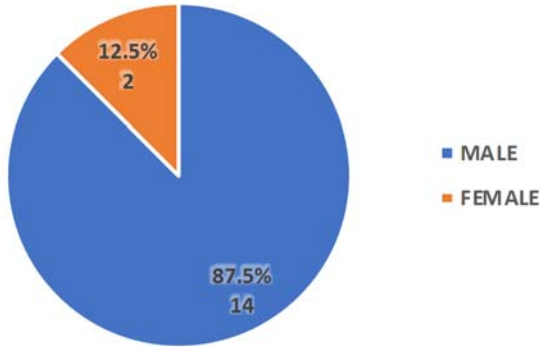

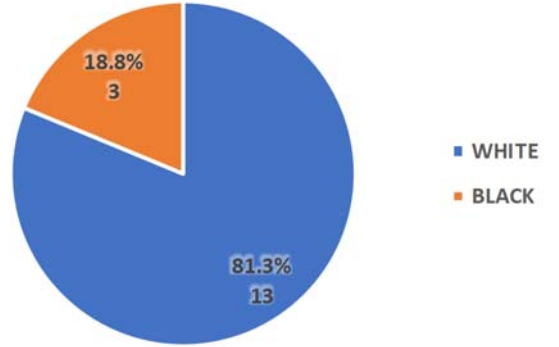

- 73% OF OFFICERS INVOLVED IN A USE OF FORCE WITH AN IMPACT WEAPON WERE ASSIGNED TO PATROL
- 60% OF OFFICERS INVOLVED IN A USE OF FORCE WITH AN IMPACT WEAPON WERE DISPATCHED
- ALL SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN A USE OF FORCE WITH AN IMPACT WEAPON WERE MALE

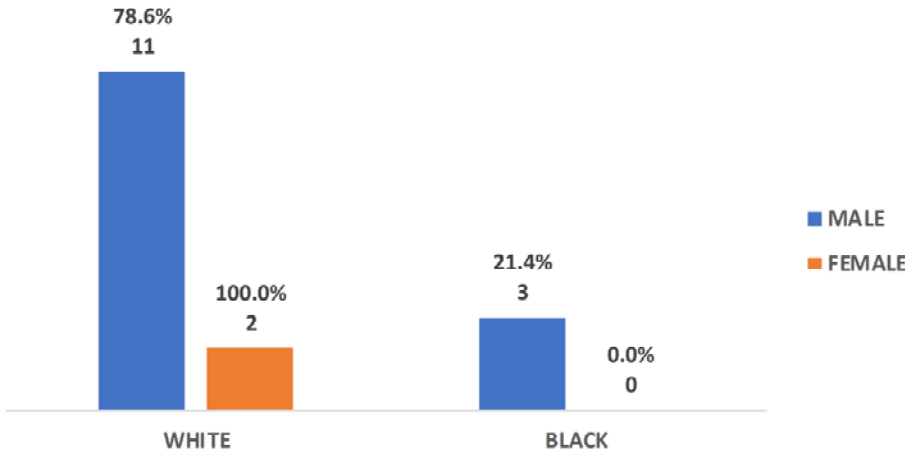

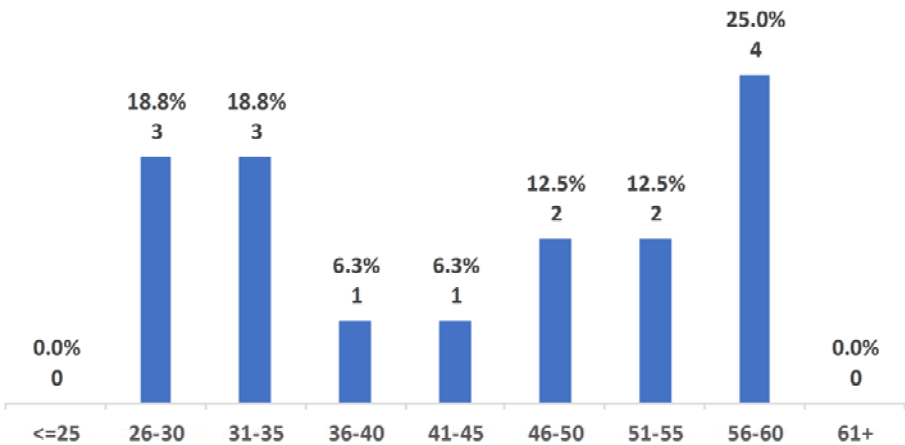

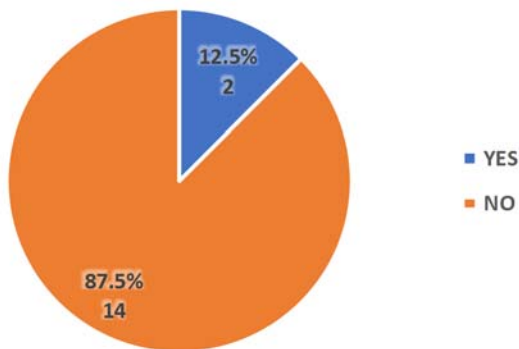

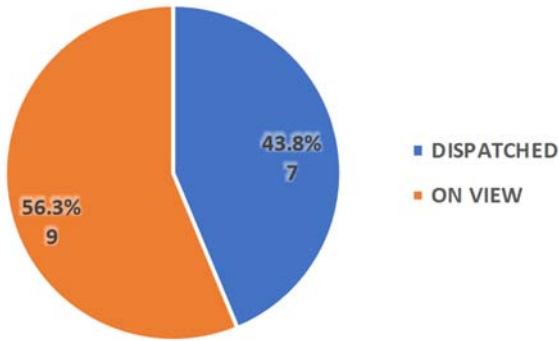
**OC SPRAY  
POLICE OFFICERS INJURED**



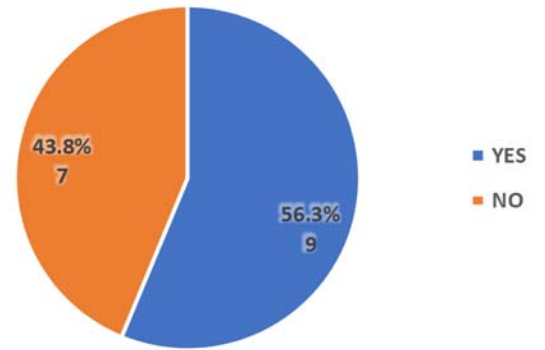

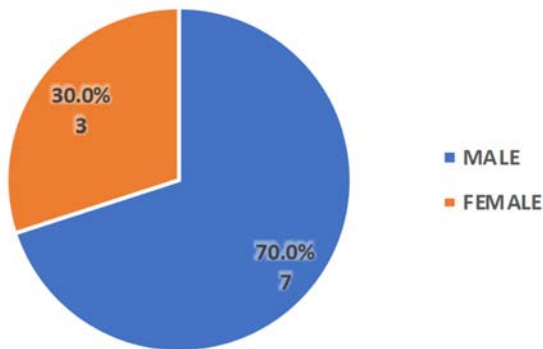

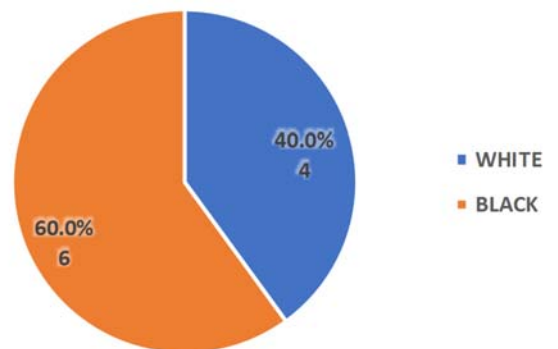


- MAJORITY OF USES OF FORCE INVOLVING OC SPRAY INVOLVED AN OFFICER WHO ON VIEWED THE ACTIVITY AT 56.3% (AS COMPARED TO 54.3% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 56.3% OF USES OF OC SPRAY RESULTED IN SUSPECTS COMPLYING

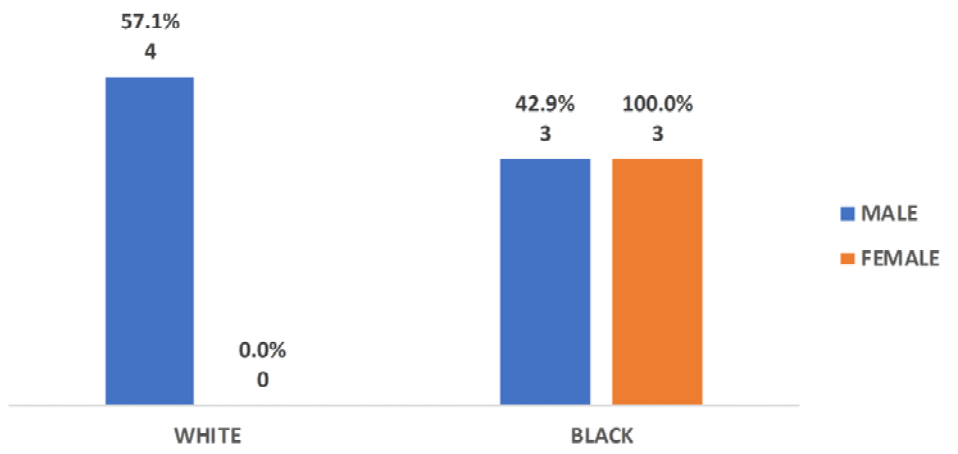

SUSPECTS BY RACE



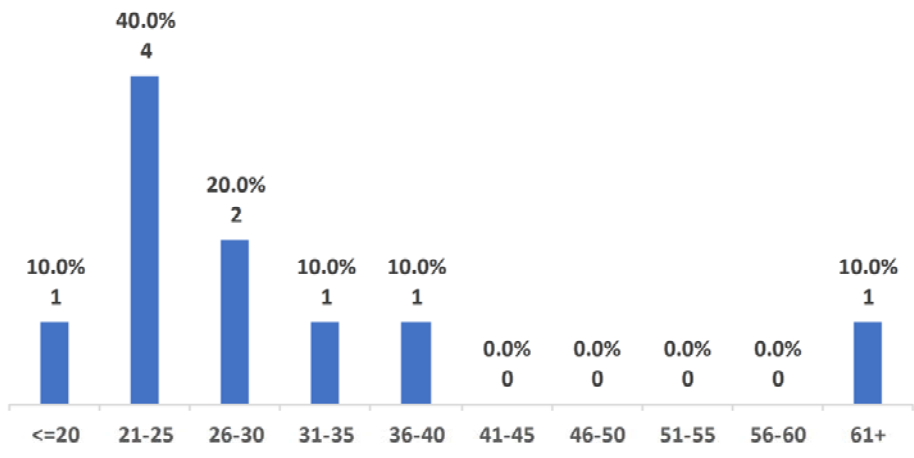

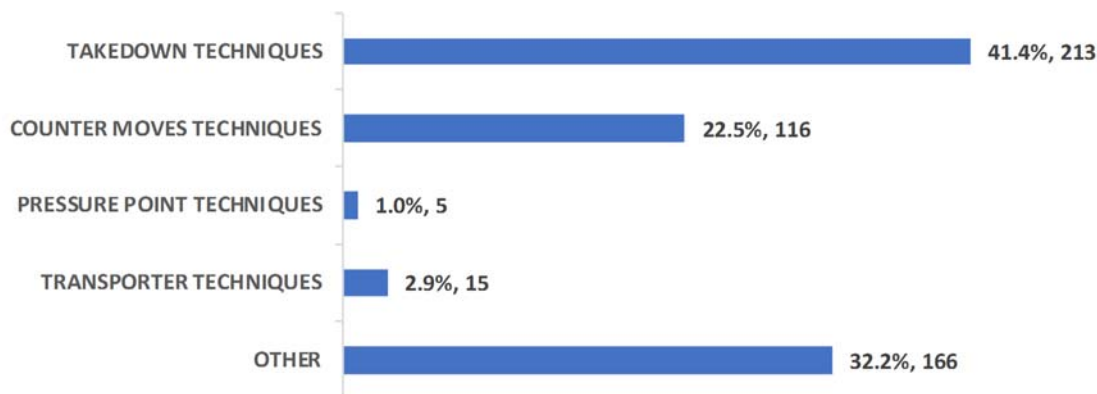

SUSPECTS BY AGE**



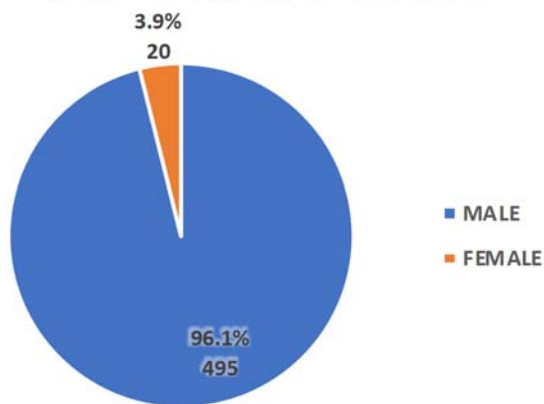

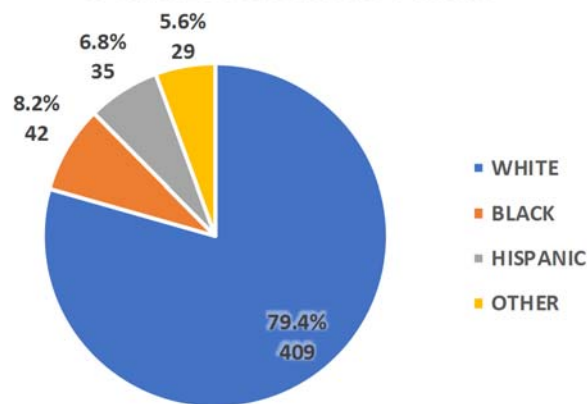

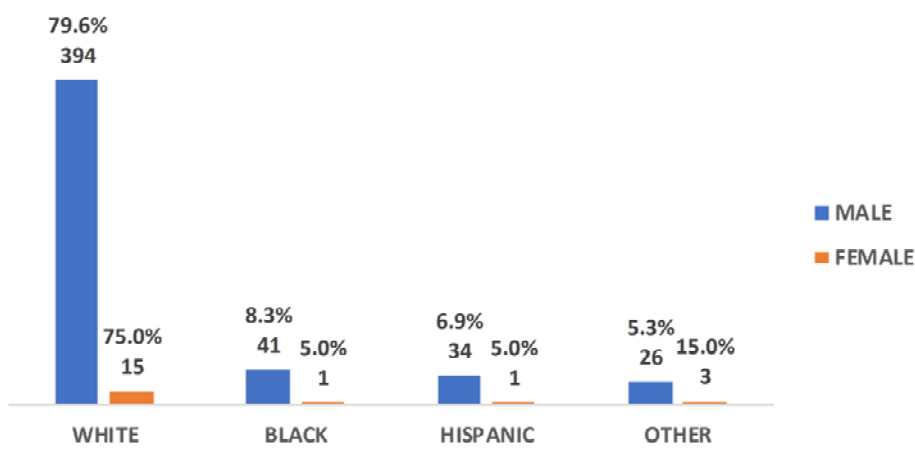
**PHYSICAL FORCE

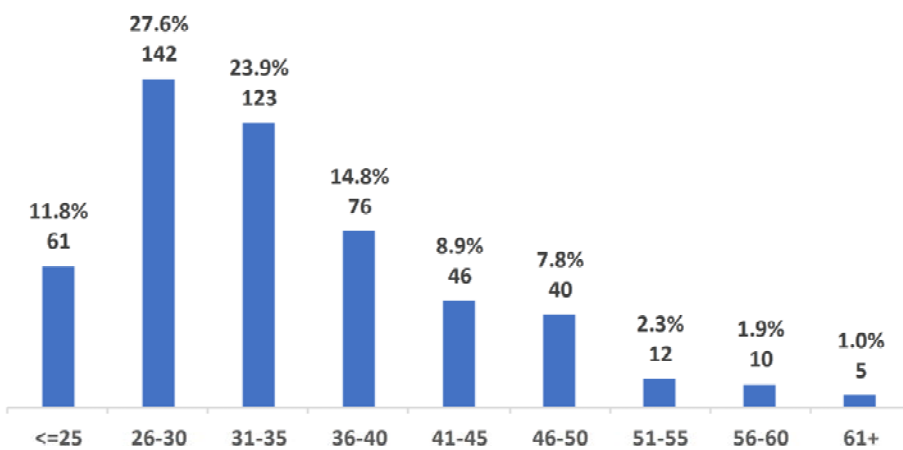

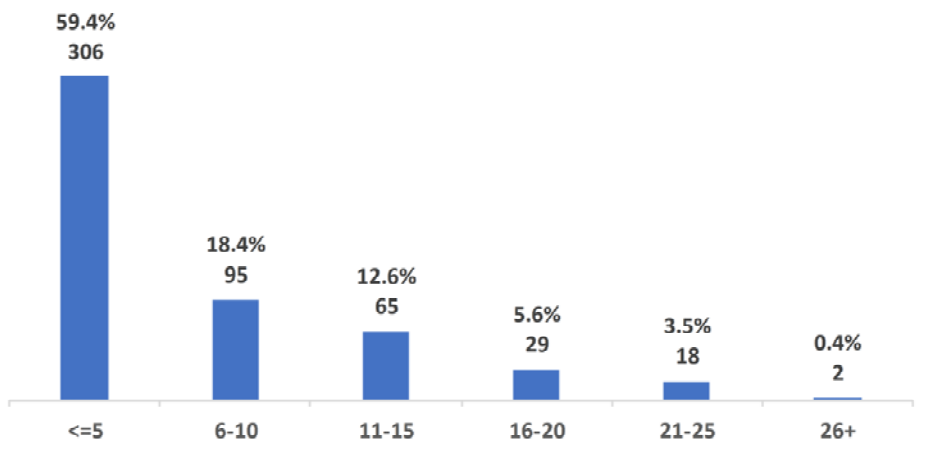

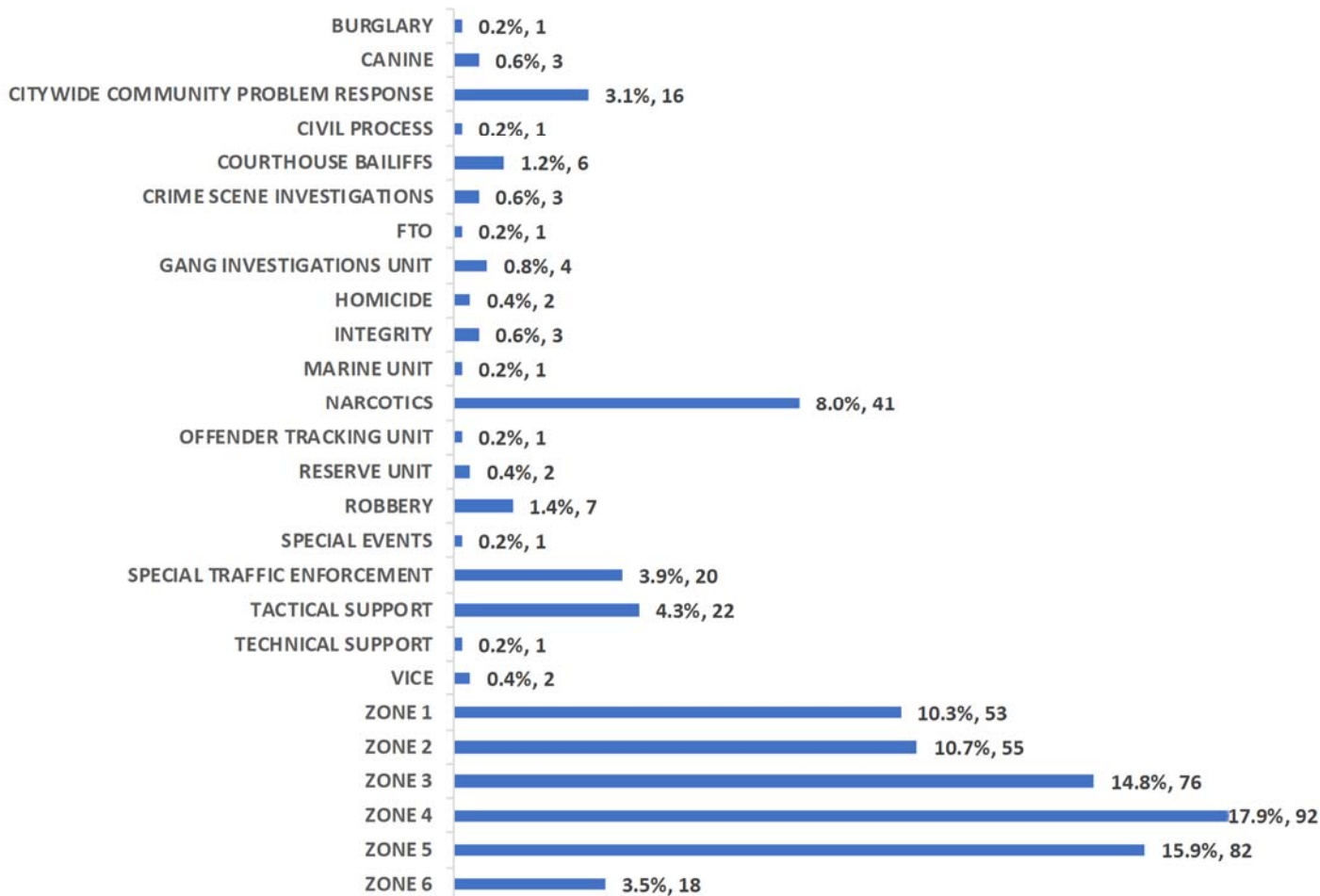


**PHYSICAL FORCE  
POLICE OFFICERS BY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE**

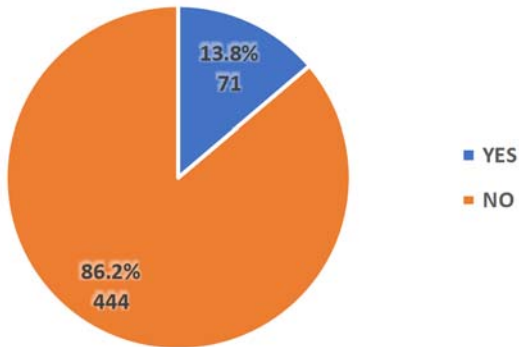

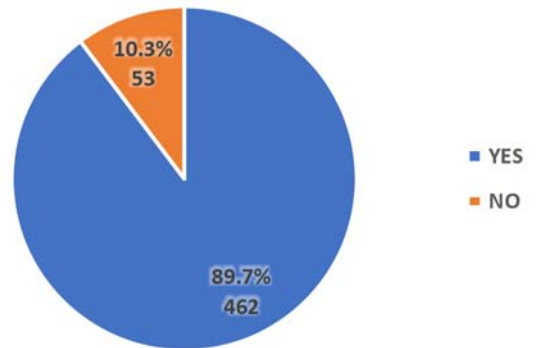

POLICE OFFICERS BY DIVISION**



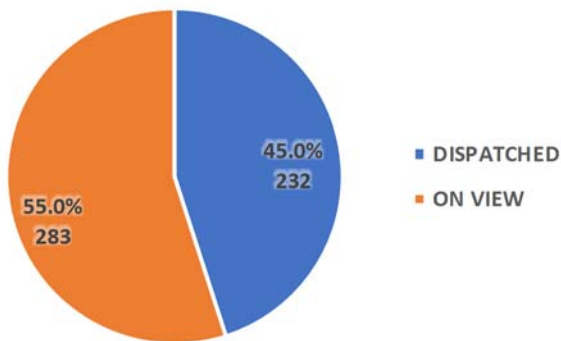
PHYSICAL FORCE

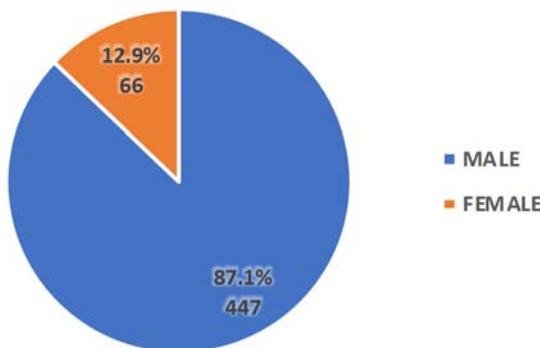

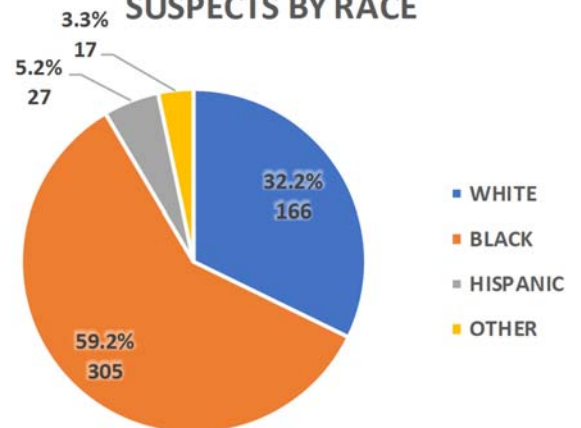

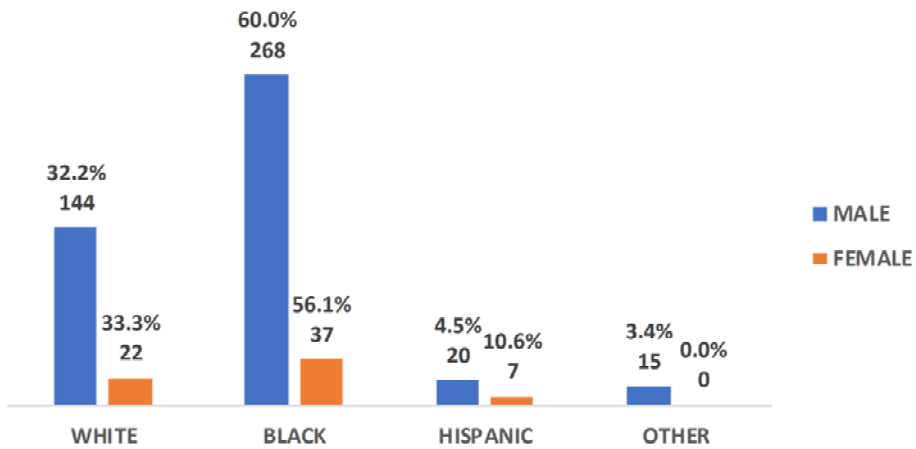
PHYSICAL FORCE

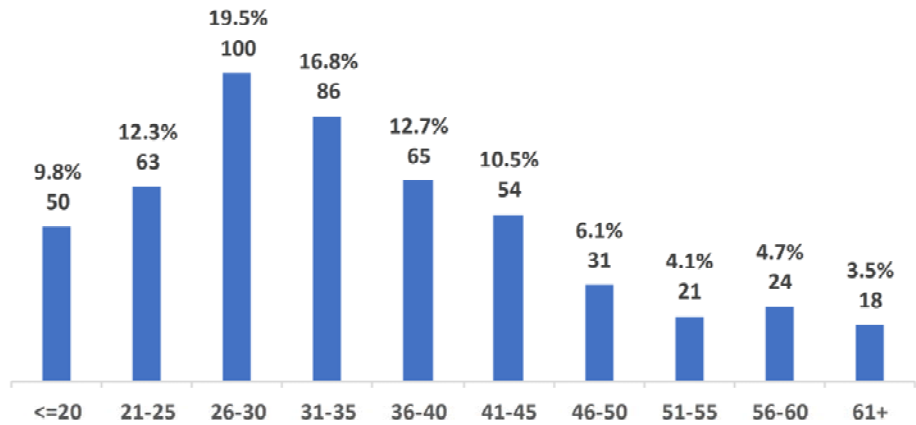

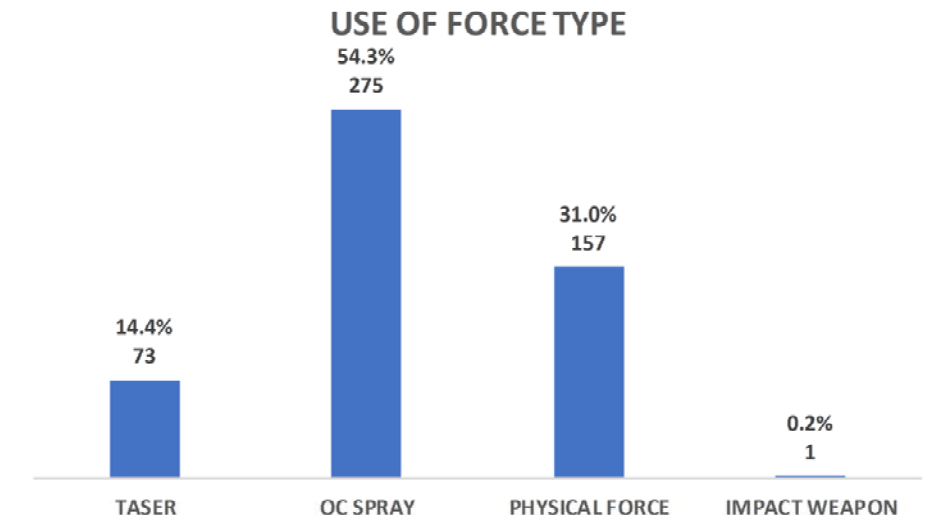

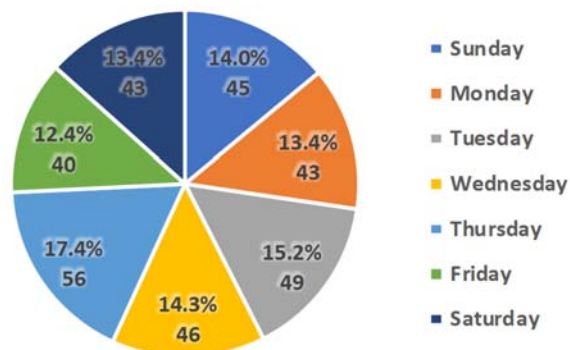

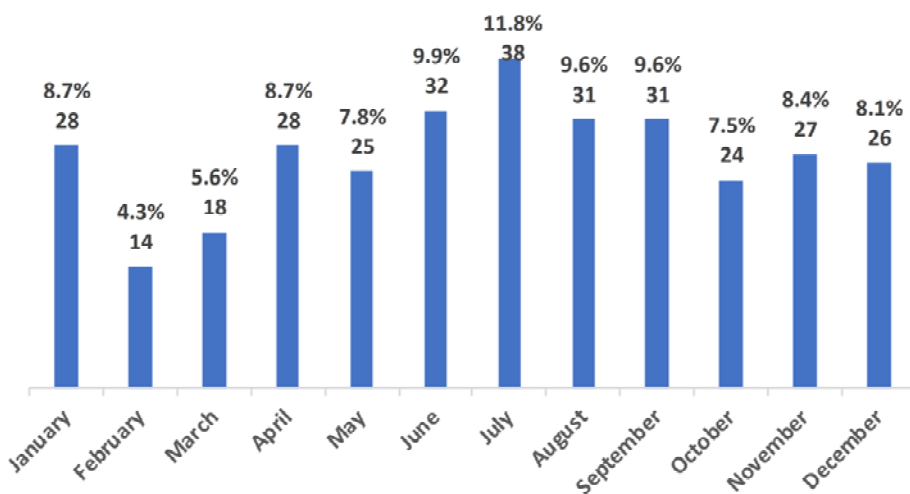
INCIDENTS BY LOCATION



INCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK

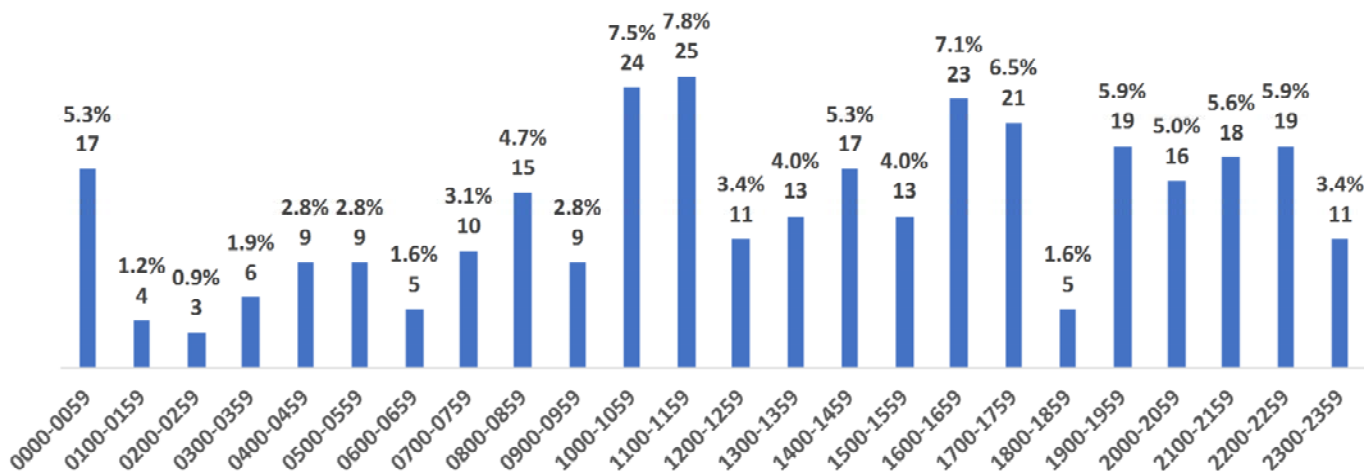

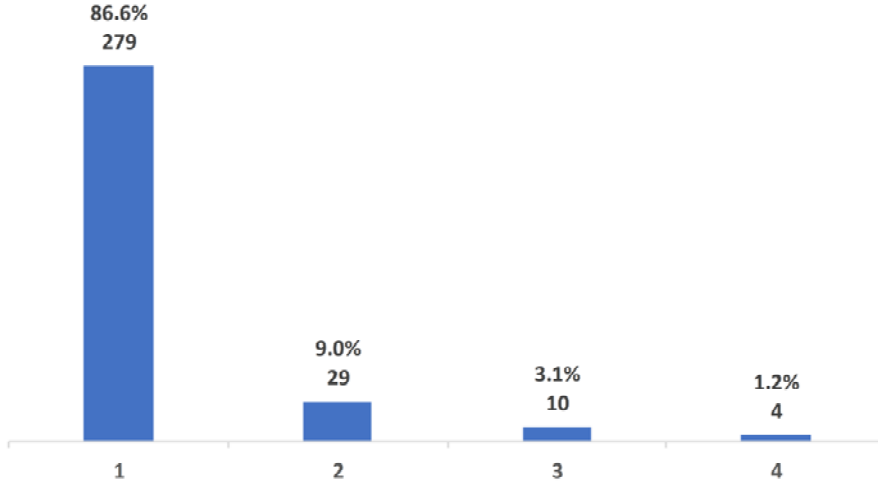

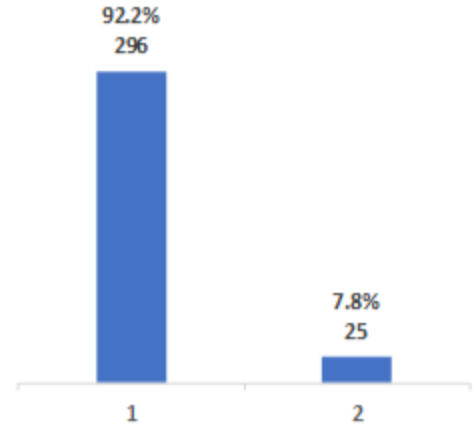
INCIDENTS BY TIME OF DAY



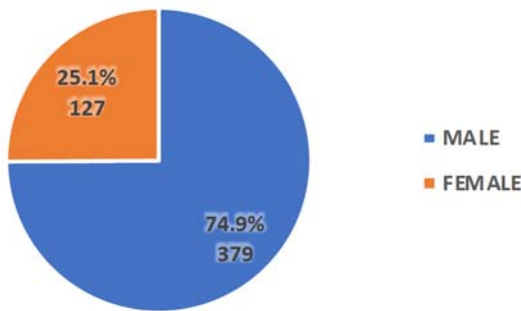
INCIDENTS BY NUMBER OF OFFICERS



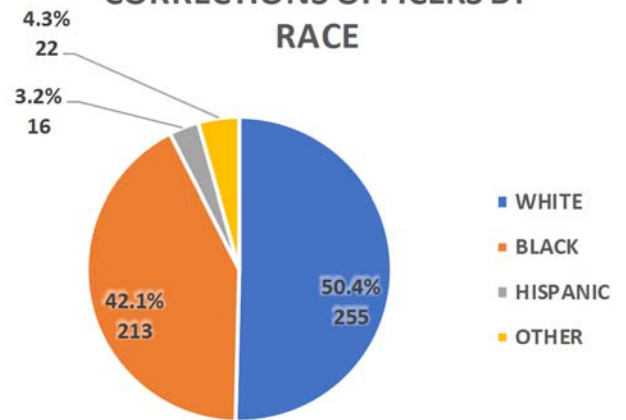
INCIDENTS BY NUMBER OF INMATES



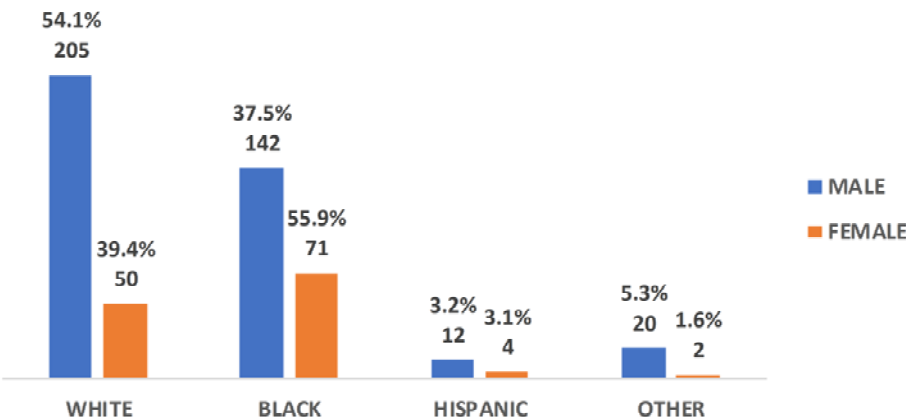
USE OF FORCE CORRECTIONS OFFICERS BY GENDER

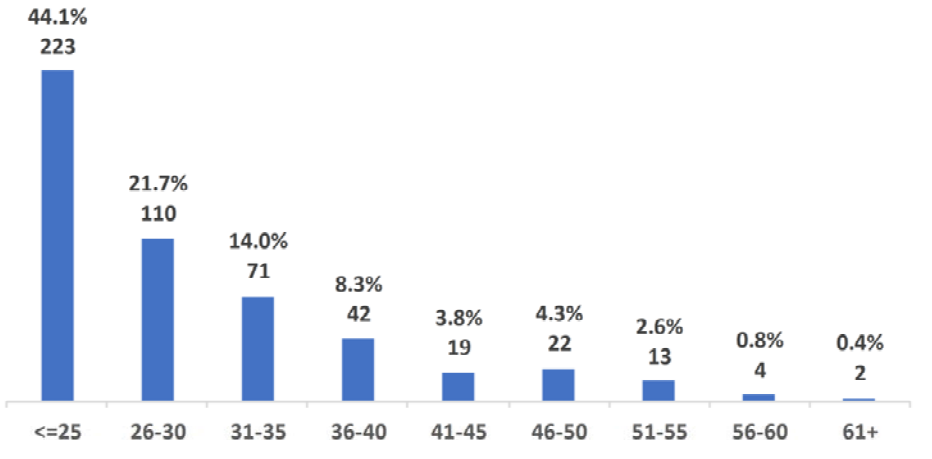

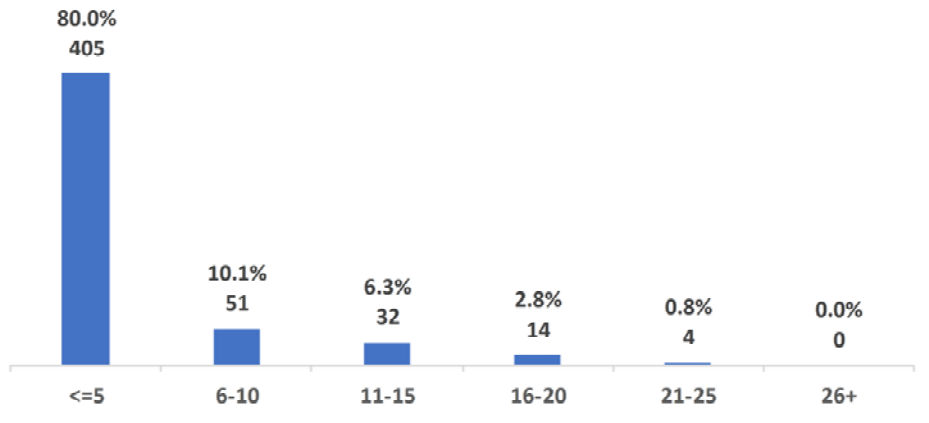

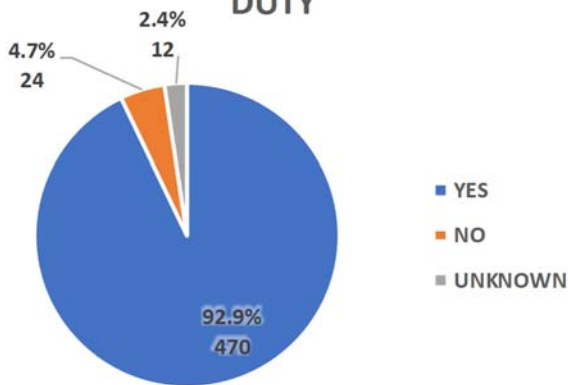

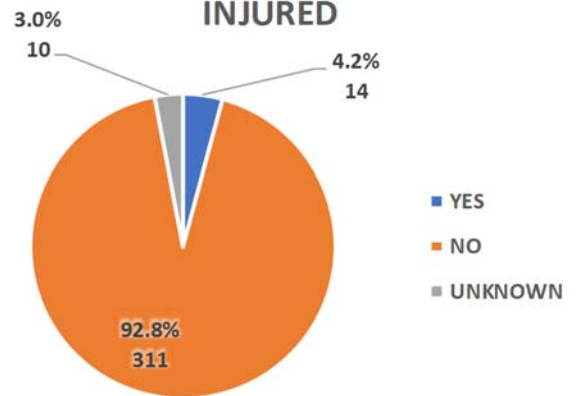

CORRECTIONS OFFICERS BY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE



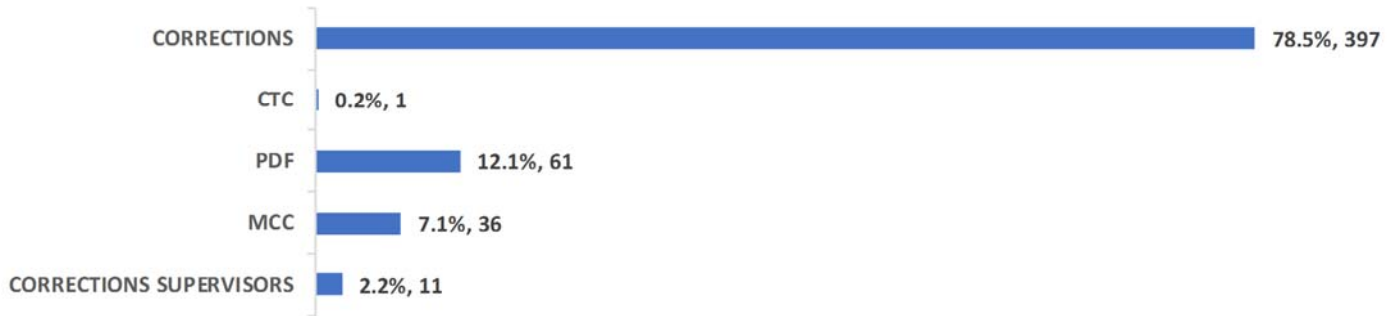
USE OF FORCE  
CORRECTIONS OFFICERS ON DUTY



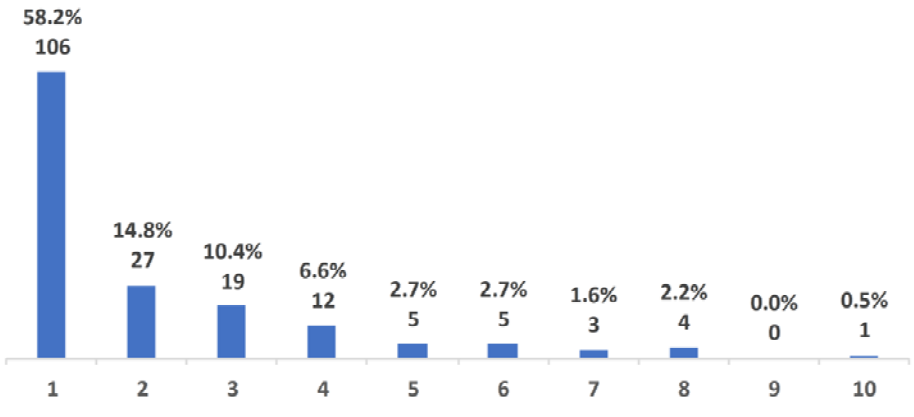

CORRECTIONS OFFICERS INJURED



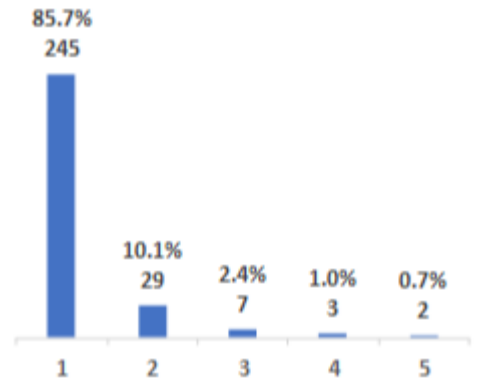

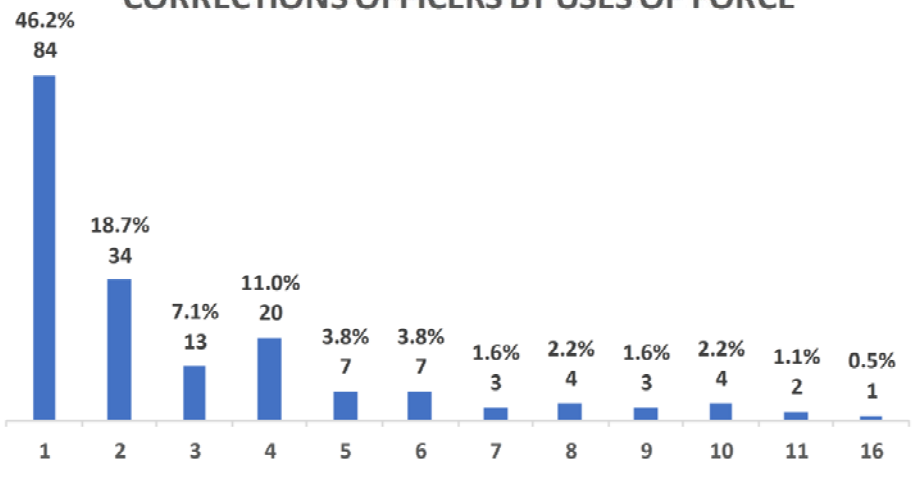

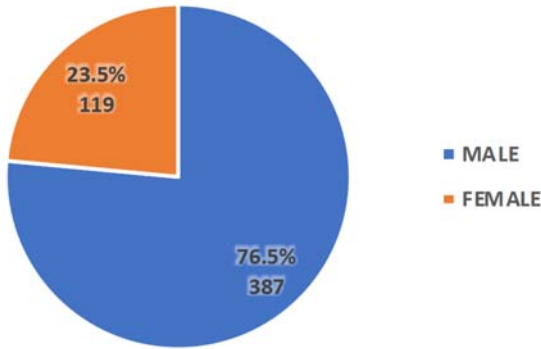

CORRECTIONS OFFICERS BY USES OF FORCE

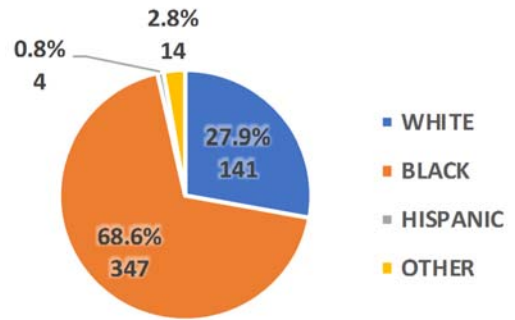

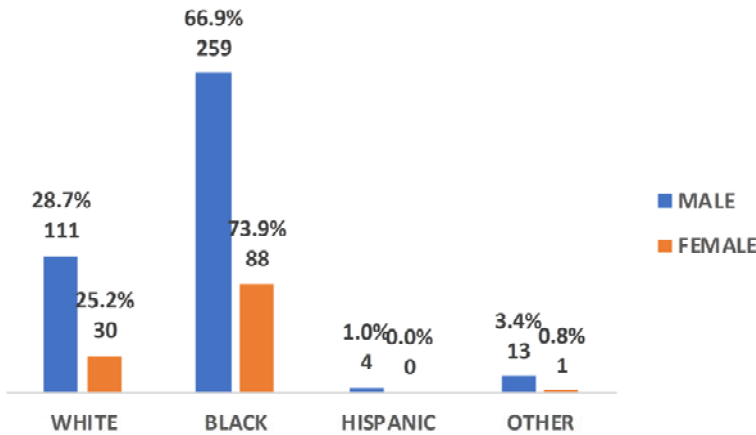
USE OF FORCE INMATES BY GENDER



USE OF FORCE INMATES BY RACE

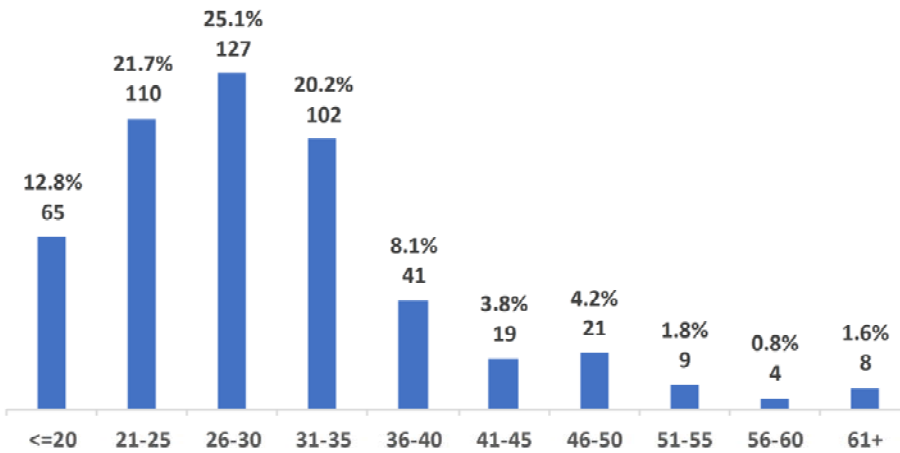

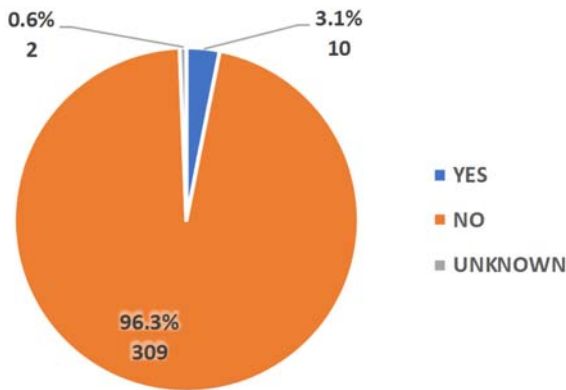

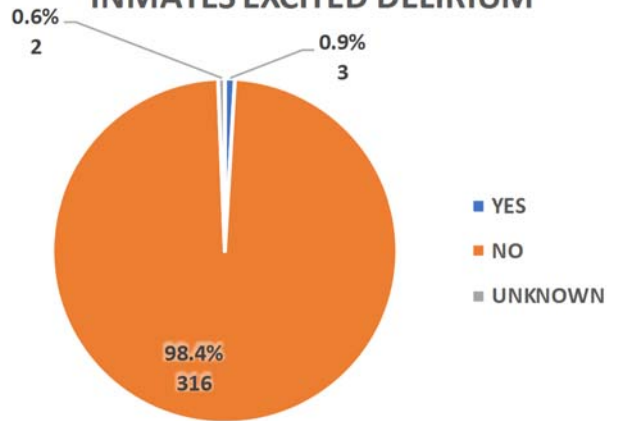

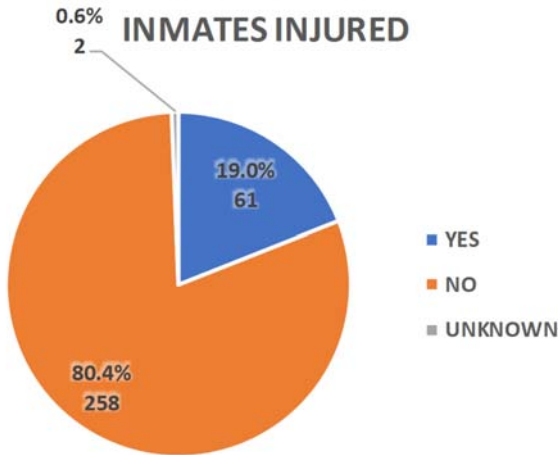

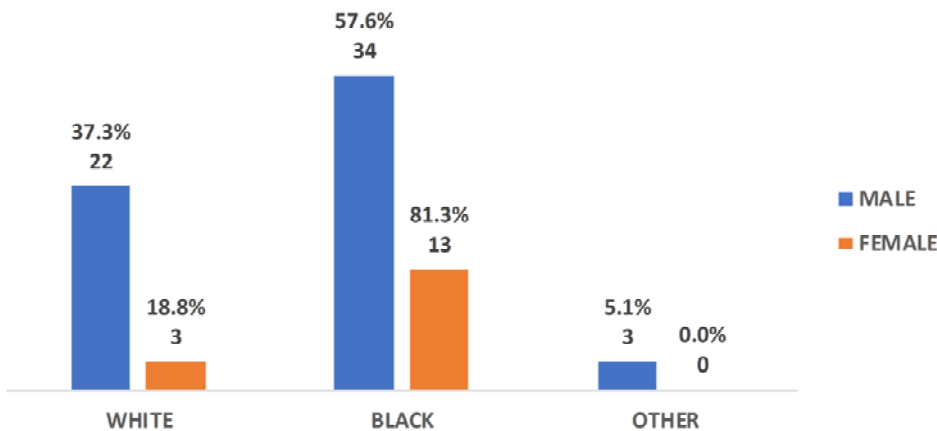

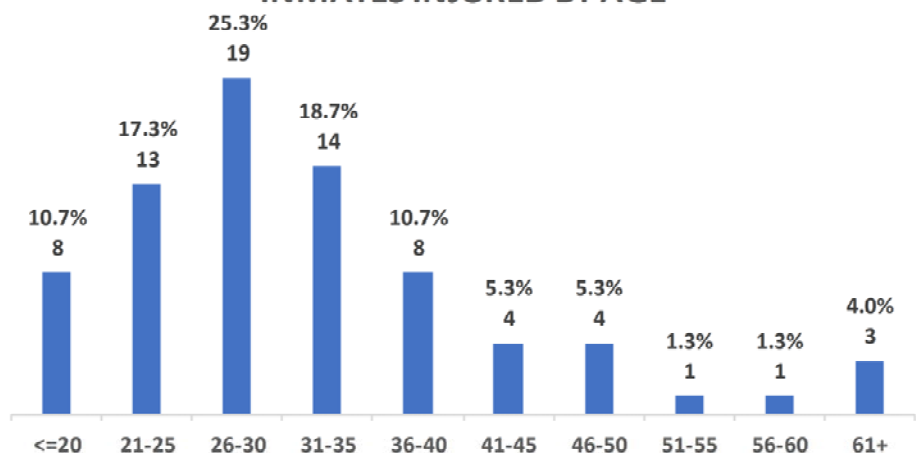

INMATES INJURED BY GENDER AND RACE**

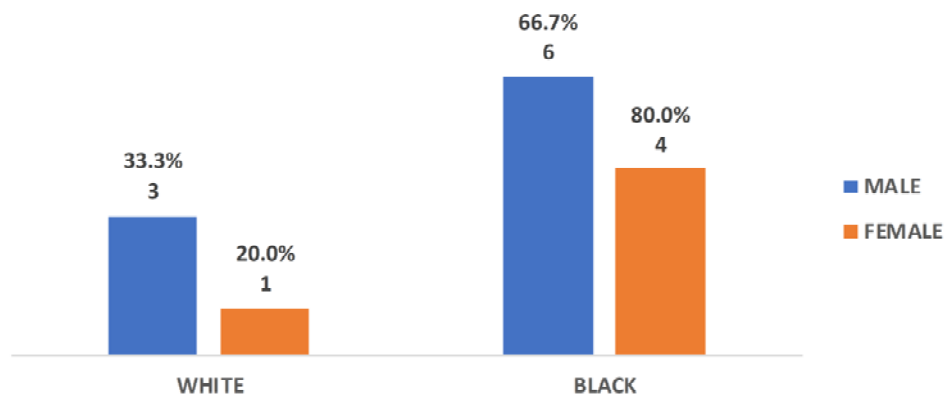

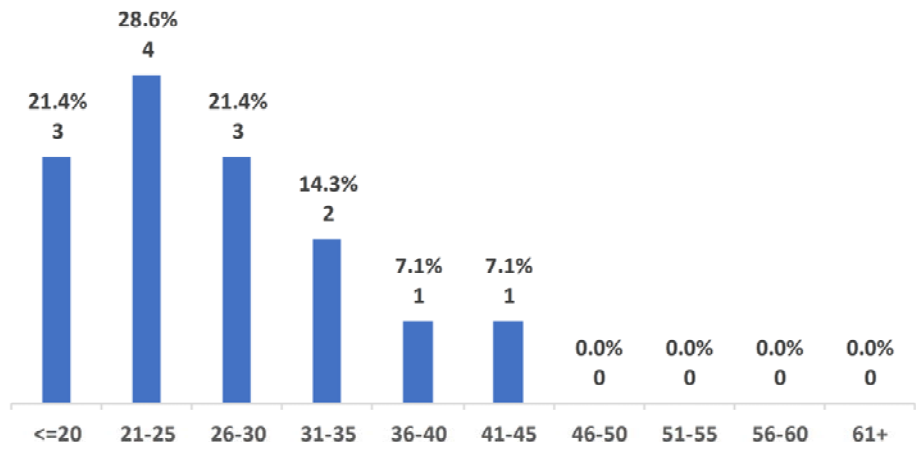

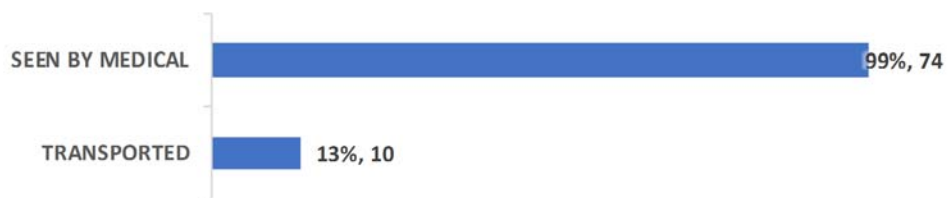
