




INCIDENTS BY LOCATION TYPE











POLICE OFFICERS BY GENDER



POLICE OFFICERS BY RACE









USE OF FORCE CALL TYPE


USE OF FORCE POLICE OFFICERS BY DIVISION




USE OF FORCE POLICE OFFICERS BY NUMBER OF INCIDENTS










USE OF FORCE SUSPECTS DISPOSITIONS




USE OF FORCE SUSPECTS BY GENDER


USE OF FORCE SUSPECTS DRUG USE






FIREARM POLICE OFFICERS BY DIVISION









FIREARM SUSPECTS BY GENDER





- 79.4% OF USES OF FORCE WITH USE OF PHYSICAL FORCE INVOLVED WHITE OF-FICERS (AS COMPARED TO 76.4% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- IN 394 OUT OF 515 (79.6%) USES OF FORCE INVOLVING PHYSICAL FORCE, THE OFFICERS WERE WHITE MALES (AS COMPARED TO 72.8% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)
- 63.3% OF USES OF FORCE WITH USE OF PHYSICAL FORCE INVOLVED OFFICERS WHO WERE 35 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER (AS COMPARED TO 67% OF ALL USES OF FORCE)




PHYSICAL FORCE POLICE OFFICERS BY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE




PHYSICAL FORCE POLICE OFFICERS BY DIVISION




PHYSICAL FORCE














INCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK








INCIDENTS BY TIME OF DAY






















USE OF FORCE CORRECTIONS OFFICERS BY DIVISION








USE OF FORCE INMATES BY NUMBER OF INCIDENTS






USE OF FORCE INMATES BY GENDER



USE OF FORCE INMATES BY RACE




USE OF FORCE INMATES BY AGE






- 45.3% OF INMATES REPORTED AS INJURED WERE BLACK MALES



INMATES INJURED BY GENDER AND RACE






- 72% OF INMATES INJURED WERE 35 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER

- MAJORITY (99%) OF INMATE INJURIES
 WERE SEEN BY MEDICAL
- OTHER INJURY COMPRISED MOSYT OF THE REPORTED INMATE INJURIES AT 32.1%, FOLLOWED BY ABRASIONS (22.6%) AND LACERATIONS (19%)
